I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file: First Amendment to Agreement (R2008-0078) with Palm Beach County XXtreme Heat, Inc. for Girls U14 traveling basketball team tournament expenses.

Summary: This fully executed First Amendment to Agreement in an amount not-to-exceed \$12,100 extends the project completion date from November 30, 2007, to April 1, 2008, and the term of the Agreement from March 1, 2008, to April 1, 2008, in order to allow additional time to accommodate dates of payment and completion of the reimbursement process. The Amendment is in accordance with Resolution R2005-1738 authorizing the delegation of authority for amending RAP agreements to the County Administrator or his designee. All other terms of the Agreement, including the funding amount, remain the same. Funding for the project is from the Recreation Assistance Program (RAP) District 7 Funds. District 7 (AH)

Background and Justification: Resolution R-2005-1738 was adopted by the Board on September 13, 2005, to streamline the RAP reimbursement process. It establishes terms and conditions for amending RAP projects and delegates authority for the execution of the amendments to the County Administrator or his designee, which is the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department. The criteria for delegated signature of amendments on behalf of the Board include:

- Changes in project scope/elements within the intent of the approved RAP project;
- Adjustments in budgetary line items within the intent of the approved RAP Project which do not change the contractual amount;
- Changes to the approved project time frame including the initiation date and/or project completion date for periods of less than one year; and
- Other miscellaneous modifications approved by the awarding Commissioner within the overall intent of the approved RAP project.

This delegation of authority allows for more efficient and timely reimbursements for RAP projects by streamlining the existing RAP process for amendments to agreements. FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY AND PALM BEACH COUNTY XXTREME HEAT INC. FOR GIRLS U14 TRAVELING BASKETBALL TEAM TOURNAMENT EXPENSES

THIS AMENDMENT is entered into on _____, by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "County", and Palm Beach County Xxtreme Heat, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit corporation, herein referred to as "Xxtreme Heat".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on January 15, 2008, County entered into an Agreement (R-2008-0078) with XXtreme Heat, hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement" to provide Recreation Assistance Program (RAP) funding in an amount not to exceed \$12,100 to assist with expenses for the Girls U14 Traveling Basketball Team tournament, hereinafter referred to as the "Project"; and

WHEREAS, XXtreme Heat has requested that County change the term of the Agreement from March 1, 2008, to April 1, 2008; and

WHEREAS, XXtreme Heat has requested that County change the Project time frame from February 1, 2007, through November 30, 2007, to February 1, 2007, through April 1, 2008, in order to allow additional project completion time and to accommodate the necessary time for the reimbursement process; and

WHEREAS, the Project will benefit all citizens of Palm Beach County.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. Section 8 of the Agreement is amended to read: "The term of this Agreement shall be until April 1, 2008, commencing upon the date of execution by the parties hereto."

2. Section 11 of the Agreement is amended to read "XXtreme Heat shall complete the project by April 1, 2008, and invoices and checks and/or proof of payments submitted for reimbursement must be dated within the Project time frame of February 1, 2007, through April 1, 2008. XXtreme Heat shall provide its final reimbursement request(s), including a project completion statement and reimbursement documentation as indicated in Section 2 above on or before April 1, 2008."

3. Except as provided herein, each and every other term of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and the Agreement is reaffirmed as modified herein.
