I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

- **A)** Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to Project Agreement R2005-1059 in the amount of \$18,312.97 with Bowyer-Singleton & Associates, Inc., for professional services.
- **B)** A Budget Transfer of \$26,578 in the Transportation Improvement Fund from FY 2005 Road Program Reserve for Plans and Alignment to Westgate Avenue from Congress Avenue to Australian Avenue.

Summary: This Supplemental Agreement will provide the additional services necessary to study an additional alignment alternative for Westgate Avenue from Congress Avenue to Australian Avenue.

District: 2 (PK)

Background and Justification: On June 7, 2005, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approved an Agreement (R2005-1059) with Bowyer-Singleton & Associates, Inc., (BSA) to provide professional services required for the preparation of an alignment study for Westgate Avenue from Congress Avenue to Australian Avenue (Project). Palm Beach County now desires BSA to provide additional professional services to evaluate an additional alignment alternative for the Project, as detailed in Exhibit "A" of the attached Supplemental Agreement. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) goal for the Project is 15%. Due to the nature of the requested additional services, SBE participation was not feasible for this supplement. The fee, as detailed in Exhibit "A" of the attached Supplemental Agreement, has been negotiated as just and reasonable compensation as follows:



WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the COUNTY and CONSULTANT entered into a Project Agreement dated June 7, 2005 (R2005-1059), to provide professional engineering services for the preparation of an alignment study for Westgate Avenue from Congress Avenue to Australian Avenue, Palm Beach County, Florida (hereinafter PROJECT); and.

WHEREAS, the COUNTY now desires for the CONSULTANT to provide additional services necessary to study a new alternative alignment for the PROJECT; and

WHEREAS, the following fee has been negotiated as just and reasonable compensation for these professional services to be performed by the CONSULTANT:

Basic Services in a lump sum fee of \$17,542.97;

Reimbursable Services (Not to Exceed) \$770.00;

Totaling \$18,312.97

NOW, THEREFORE, THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the mutual benefits to flow from each to the other, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. The **CONSULTANT** agrees to provide professional services as described in Exhibit "A" of the Agreement known as "SCOPE OF WORK & FEE".
- 2. The **CONSULTANT** agrees to "CERTIFICATION" statements as described in Exhibit "B" of the Agreement.
- 3. The **CONSULTANT** agrees to Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Participation, described in Exhibit "C" of the Agreement.
- 4. The COUNTY agrees to pay the CONSULTANT a fee of Eighteen Thousand Three Hundred Twelve Dollars and Ninety-Seven Cents (\$18,312.97).
- 5. The CONSULTANT agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the COUNTY against all claims that may arise as a result of negligence, wrongdoing, misconduct or want of care by the CONSULTANT.

Congress Avenue to Australian Avenue (Approximately 1.00 mile) PBCo. Proj. # 2004515

PHASE I ALIGNMENT STUDY: SCOPE OF SERVICES

Project Description

The project consists of study/consultant services necessary to study the new alignment of Westgate Avenue, from Congress Avenue to Australian Avenue. The roadway extension will consist of a five (5) lane typical section. The project will include preliminary engineering, conceptual plans, drainage analysis, and all other plan work necessary to result in a complete analysis of the additional alignment option. THE WORK PERFORMED UNDER THIS ADDITIONAL SERVICES SCOPE IN IS ADDITION TO THE WORK ALREADY COMPLETED FOR THE PROJECT UNDER THE ORIGINAL SCOPE OF SERVICES. The additional option includes the following:

Utilize Old Okeechobee Road alignment and relocate the Congress/Westgate intersection

Analysis will address the following:

- Safety
- Cost
- Environmental factors

Project Location

The proposed Westgate Avenue corridor addressed in this agreement is approximately one (1) mile (five thousand two hundred and eighty (5,280) linear feet) in length and extends from Congress Avenue to Australian Avenue; lying in Sections 29 and 30 of Township 43 South, and Range 43 East in Palm Beach County, Florida.

ROADWAYS

All conceptual plans shall be prepared in accordance with the latest editions of the Palm Beach County Thoroughfare Road Design Procedure Manual, Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, Federal Highway Administration/AASHTO publications, and all other applicable requirements. All plans shall be accurate, legible, complete, and drawn to the appropriate scale.

The Consultant shall be responsible for the planning, preliminary design, and preparation of alternative alignment plans for the roadway improvements.

Design will include:

- All alignment and geometric calculations necessary to define complete right-of-way requirements
- Preliminary Drainage Design
- Statement of Design Criteria Used
- Any other information that may be considered critical to the development of the alignment analysis. This information and development of conceptual plans will be organized in a usable format and included in the design documentation provided to Palm Beach County.

Preliminary Engineering

A Preliminary Engineering study will be performed to identify alternative typical sections and alignments. Alternative improvement concepts will be developed, analyzed, and compared. A combination of typical section and alignment alternatives will be developed and a matrix analysis performed to select a preferred improvement concept. The previous Preliminary Engineering Report will be REVISED to summarize all developed alternatives and all items used to support the final recommendations.

Intersections

The conceptual plans will include all design features of the intersections located at Congress Avenue, Church Street, Florida Mango Road, and Australian Avenue. Design features shall include the appropriate tapers, transitions, deceleration lanes, storage lanes, radii of turning roadway, curb radii and offsets, lane widths, channelizing features, and other appurtenances that may be determined to be needed. The design features shall be identified based on the Palm Beach County Thoroughfare Road Design Procedure Manual, Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices, Federal Highway Administration/AASHTO publications, or be justifiable modifications thereto approved, in writing, by the County. Appropriate consideration shall be given to both crossing and stopping sight distances at all intersections for each predominant vehicle type. Consideration shall be given to vehicle type, operating speed, positive drainage, and to non-motorized and pedestrian traffic when applicable.

Palm Beach County will determine the lane configuration for all intersecting street designs. Round-a-bout configurations are not a part of this scope.

Internal (PEER) Review of Construction Plans / Documents

The Consultant shall perform an internal/in-house (Peer) review/detailed checking of all in-progress and/or final Drainage and Quantity calculations, Schematic Drawings (typical sections, etc.), Conceptual Plans, Study Reports, and Legal Descriptions /sketches prior to any scheduled submittal to the County. Consultant Internal Peer Reviews shall encompass Engineering /Planning /Surveying decisions, drafting, accuracy, completeness, constructability/economy of construction, and compliance with all applicable design and/or permitting agency standards. The above requirements shall pertain to all work submitted to County, including that of Minority and/or other sub-consultants.

County's Responsibilities

The County will:

 Provide reviews of all construction plan/document submittals in a timely manner. (Consultant will provide review materials in accordance with the requirements of the plan.)

Cost Estimates and Quantities

The Consultant shall prepare preliminary cost estimates as defined in the Palm Beach County Thoroughfare Road Design Procedures Manual to analyze the different alignment options.

Schedule of Activities, Phase Reviews and Submittals

The Consultant will complete preparation of all study documents and conceptual plans within eight (8) months of the Notice to Proceed. The Consultant will deliver to the County's designated Program Manager the required completed work product. The County will review the completed work and return the comments to the Consultant within twenty one (21) calendar days.

The schedules allow for a twenty one (21) calendar day review time by the County. Should more time be required for review, the Consultant's date for completion will be extended to accommodate the revised review period.

The County's review time shall start when all required deliverables have been received and end with the return shipment of the review comments.

A transmittal letter shall accompany each submittal and, in addition to the normal information required of a transmittal letter, it shall include the following:

- Documentation of major changes made since the last submittal.
- List of all design exceptions that are required and rational for their requirement.
- List of all design parameter changes and the rational for their requirement.

ENGINEERING

The Consultant shall provide all services required for the preparation of the conceptual plans and study documents for the project. These services shall include, but not be limited to, preliminary engineering designs and conceptual plans for the alignment alternatives and shall include, but not be limited to:

- Alternative Alignment Plans
- Alternative Typical Sections
- Cost Estimates

Conceptual plans shall be prepared in accordance with the latest editions of

- Palm Beach County's Thoroughfare Road Design Procedure Manual
- Palm Beach County's Engineering Design Typicals
- Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD)
- Federal Highway Administration / AASHTO Publications
- Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) Plans Preparation Manual
- FDOT's Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction
- FDOT's Drainage Manuals
- Latest standards adopted by AASHTO
- Federal-Aid Highway Program Manual (FHPM) (1984) 6-7-3-(2).
- All other applicable requirements

The Consultant shall also be responsible for providing continuous quality control and quality assurance reviews prior to each submittal in accordance with "standard practice" according to procedures as provided in the Consultant's QA/QC Guidelines Program. The measures to be provided shall be sufficient to establish that "due care" has been utilized in preparation of the study and documents.

Each set of concept plans for the project shall be accurate, legible, and drawn to scales indicated herein. The concept plans shall be furnished on reproducible material (mylar) approved by the County and in a format acceptable to the County.
