I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to adopt: a Resolution rescinding and replacing Resolution No. 2007-0028 pertaining to the Public Art Committee (Committee).

Summary: As the County's Art in Public Places Program continues to establish itself and take on a broad array of projects, the Public Art Committee recommends that the Committee broaden its member requirements to be more flexible to reach out to and nominate art professionals with diverse area of expertise. This resolution modifies the membership of the committee by adding a seat to the "Palm Beach County resident with significant visual art experience" category and by eliminating the "Palm Beach County citizen with a significant visual art background but no current interest in a for-profit art business" category. This resolution also adds an additional seat to the "Planning/ Design Professional" category. (FDO Admin) Countywide (MJ)

Background and Justification: On January 9, 2007 the BCC approved the latest revision to the resolution creating and governing the Public Art Committee. As the County's Art in Public Places Program continues to establish itself and take on a broad array of projects, the Public Art Committee recommends that the Committee broaden its member requirements to be more flexible to reach out to and nominate art professionals with diverse area of expertise, including professionals who are PBC citizens with a significant visual art background with a current interest in a for-profit art business. RESOLUTION NO. R2008-_____

A RESOLUTION RESCINDING R2007-0028 AND REPLACING IT WITH A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, CREATING THE PUBLIC ART COMMITTEE; PROVIDING FOR MEMBERSHIP; PROVIDING FOR MEETINGS AND ORGANIZATION; PROVIDING FOR DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS PROVIDING FOR COMMITTEE ACTION ADVISORY ONLY; PROVIDING FOR ASSISTANCE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT WITH FEDERAL OR STATE LAWS OR COUNTY ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners acknowledge the quality of works of art exhibited in the County's non-profit museums and galleries as setting a standard of excellence for art acquisition programs;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners acknowledges the mission and success of the Palm Beach International Airport and the Palm Beach County Courthouse art acquisition programs in creating an environment of visual excellence for residents and visitors through selection, acquisition and exhibition of works of art in all appropriate media, significantly but not exclusively by Florida artists, which represents the best in Florida visual style, spirit and diversity, as recommended by a group including recognized county art experts; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners acknowledge the success of the recently completed "Call to Artists" for the creation of an aesthetically-appealing solution to security barriers, combining artistic beauty with public safety at the Palm Beach County Main Courthouse; and

WHEREAS, the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners recognizes the role of Public Art Committee plays in advising the County in an overall public art policy, in the direction of public art in Palm Beach County, and in the integration of artistic elements into the planning, design and engineering process of County facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to create an advisory committee to recommend to the Board of County Commissioners the selection, acquisition and placement of works of art in and on County-owned facilities and properties.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1. Creation. Upon adoption of this Resolution by the Board of County Commissioners, there is created and established a committee to be known as the Public Art Committee ("Committee").

Section 2. Duties and Functions. The Committee shall advise the Board of County Commissioners as to; a) the overall art policy in Palm Beach County; b) set the direction and conduct the selection of all County works of art, whether loaned, donated or purchased, and c) develop an educational program to expand the traditional definition and perception of art and the benefit of incorporating artwork into public design projects.

Section 3. Membership.

A. The Committee shall be staffed by one or more staff members of Facilities Development & Operations. The Committee shall consist of ten (10) members - 9 regular; 1 alternate who shall be appointed by the Board of County Commissioners as follows:

1. One (1) member shall be the Chair of the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County or his or her commissioner designees, and shall act as Chair of the Public Arts Committee.

2. ~~One (1)~~ Two (2) members shall be an Urban Planner or Architectural Design professional. One shall be a regular Committee member; one shall be an Alternate member.

3. One (1) member shall be the Board of Directors of the Palm Beach County Cultural Council, as recommended by the Cultural Council.

4. Two (2) members shall be Palm Beach County professional nonprofit visual art administrators.

5. ~~Two (2) members shall be Palm Beach County citizens with a significant visual art background but no current interest in a for-profit art business.~~

~~6.5. Two (2) Three (3) members shall be Palm Beach County residents with significant visual art background. One shall be a regular Committee member, one shall be an alternate member. If the number of regular attendees is less than 5, and the Alternate is in attendance, they will be permitted to vote. The Alternate will have the same opportunity to provide input on Committee discussions and direction setting as regular members. However, the Alternate is only permitted to vote when a quorum is not met for an individual meeting.~~

7. 6. One (1) member shall be a Landscape Architect.

B. Appointment of new members to fill vacancies in the Committee created by resignation shall be made by the Board of County Commissioners as recommended by the person, group or entity that was responsible for recommending the original appointment.

C. One member of the Committee shall be designated as an Alternate. The Alternate may fill any seat on the Committee except for Board of County Commissioner seat as set forth in Section 3.A.1. The Alternate will have the same opportunity to provide input on Committee discussions and direction setting as regular members. If the number of regular attendees is less than 5, and the Alternate is in attendance, they will be permitted to vote. However, the Alternate is only permitted to vote when a quorum is not met for an individual meeting.

D. Any selection committee convened for the purpose of selecting or commissioning a work of art for placement of artwork within a courthouse or on the site of a courthouse shall include the Chief Judge or his/her designee as a voting member.

E. Any selection committee convened for the purpose of selecting or commissioning an exterior work of art or for placement of artwork on a site within municipal limits shall include a representative of the municipality as a voting member. The municipality shall designate its representative.

F. Any selection committee convened for the purpose of selecting or commissioning a work of art or for placement of artwork at a facility or site occupied or managed by a County department shall include a representative of the user department as a voting member. The department director shall be the department representative.

G. All selection committees convened for the purpose of selecting or commissioning a work of art or for placement of artwork at a County owned facility or site shall include the District County Commissioner as a voting member.

H. The Committee shall have the ability to identify and include additional voting members to any selection committee if the Committee believes it is necessary to ensure appropriate artistic, technical or community input.

Section 4. Meetings and Organizations. The Committee shall establish a time and place for holding meetings as may be necessary and shall adopt such rules or organization and procedure as may be required. The Committee shall appoint a vice chairman, may establish subcommittees for specific subjects or tasks and may invite participation in the subcommittee by non-members in order to obtain input from other sectors of the public interested in the selection,

acquisition, and siting of works of art. All meetings of the Committee and any of its sub-committees shall be open to the public, duly advertised and otherwise comply with all applicable requirements of Florida's Government in the Sunshine and Public Records laws.

Section 5. Committee Action Advisory Only. The actions, decisions and recommendations of the Committee shall not be final or binding on the Board of County Commissioners but shall be advisory only.

Section 6. Assistance. The Committee shall be encouraged to seek additional funds from private and public foundations, private individuals, and other public agencies, including the State of Florida and the National Endowment for the Arts, for acquisition of works of art. The Committee may also consider permanent donations of art to the County, provided they meet criteria established for acquired works of art.

Section 7. Termination. The Committee shall expire and terminate five (5) years from the date of passage hereof without further action of the Board of county Commissioners, unless otherwise extended.

Section 8. Severability. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Resolution is, for any reason, held by the Court to be unconstitutional, inoperative, or void, such holding shall not affect the remainder of this Resolution.

Section 9. Conflict with Federal or State Law or County Ordinance. Any statutory or Ordinance provisions in conflict with this Resolution shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.
