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CPE and Humiston will provide professional coastal and marine engineering services on a task order basis for various projects within the Department of Environmental Resources Management and other departments. CPE has agreed to SBE-M/WBE participation of 20%. Humiston has agreed to SBE-M/WBE participation of 25%. The Contracts contain an option to renew for one (1) additional year. Countywide (JM)

Background and Justification: ATM's Contract was for two (2) years with an option to renew for one (1) additional year. There are no estimates of future work since authorizations are on a task order basis. All rates in the Contract remain in effect.

On July, 10 2007, the Board authorized the distribution of notices to consultants that were certified to perform coastal and marine engineering services. On September 27, 2007, CPE and Humiston were selected to perform the necessary professional services in accordance with the Board-adopted procedures pursuant to Section 287.055, Florida Statutes (CCNA). Projects that will require CPE's and Humiston's professional consultant services are budgeted in various capital project accounts, and will be authorized on a task order basis.
