Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file: Grant Adjustment Notice amending the Florida Department of Law Enforcement's Florida Consortium "2006 Paul Coverdell National Forensic Sciences Improvement Act" Grant for payment of staff training to extend the ending grant period from March 31, 2008 to December 31, 2008.

Summary: The Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) accepted this grant for \$39,560 on March 13, 2007; the original period for this grant was October 1, 2006 thru September 30, 2007 (R-2007-0411). On December 4, 2007, the BOCC received and filed an agenda item extending the grant period from September 30, 2007 to March 31, 2008 (R-2007-2206). This agenda item will extend the grant period from March 31, 2008 to December 31, 2008. The National Institute of Justice (NIJ) awarded these funds to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) for the "Paul Coverdell National Forensic Sciences Improvement Grant". The Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO) was awarded funds to improve the quality of forensic services. The funds are being used to train 20 staff members in expert witness court testimony techniques, and 20 managers and staff in documentation. The PBSO has been given an extension to allow the grant funds to be fully expended. There is no match requirement associated with this award. No additional positions are needed and no additional County funds are required. Countywide (DW)
