AMENDMENT #1 TO JOB ORDER CONTRACT

This agreement amends the contract between Palm Beach County (County) and H.A. Contracting Corp, (Contractor) authorized pursuant to Palm Beach County Resolution (R-2007-0944).

The original contract provided that Contractor would act as an annual general contractor from June 19, 2007 to June 18, 2008 or until Contractor had been awarded projects totaling two million, five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000), whichever occurred first. That contract also provides that it could be extended for two additional terms. This amendment is the first extension.

The County is extending the contract for a period of twelve (12) months based on expiration of the term and applying an Economic Price Adjustment of 2.81% to the Contractor's Adjustment Factors per the letter attached from The Gordian Group, dated May 12, 2008. Pursuant to the provisions of the existing contract, the parties agree that Contractor will continue to act as an annual general contractor until June 16, 2009 or until the total dollar value of work authorizations for the second term totals two million, five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000), whichever comes first. The parties agree that the total dollar value of work authorizations issued pursuant to this amendment shall not exceed two million, five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000).

Except as amended herein, all provisions of the existing contract shall remain in full force and effect.
