
Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to adopt: AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 2007-006, REVOKING THE AD VALOREM TAX EXEMPTION GRANTED TO FLORIDA TURBINE TECHNOLOGIES, INC.; PROVIDING FOR TITLE; PROVIDING FOR ENACTMENT AUTHORITY; PROVIDING FOR REVOCATION OF EXEMPTION/RECOVERY OF FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE OF LAWS AND ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.


Summary: The Board adopted Ordinance 2007-006 Economic Development Ad Valorem Tax Exemption Ordinance with Florida Turbine Technologies, Inc. on May 15, 2007. The Ordinance provided a four (4) year exemption for 100% of the assessed value of all qualifying tangible personal property acquired and added improvements to real property, excluding land. While Florida Turbine Technologies, Inc. has successfully contracted for the design, development and manufacturing of missile aerospace technology, they were unable to create and retain the required number of jobs in 2007. They received a tax exemption of \$23,104.43 for 2007. Due to their failure to achieve the job creation/retention goals, they have submitted these funds in payment of the applicable tax. Countywide (DW)

Background and Policy Issues: The County's Economic Development Ad Valorem Tax Exemption Program was implemented by the Board pursuant to authority granted in Article VII, Section 3 of the Constitution of the State of Florida and Section 196.1995, Florida Statutes, and Ordinance No. 2005-004, known as the Economic Development Ad Valorem Tax Exemption Ordinance of Palm Beach County, Florida. The Economic Development Ad Valorem Tax Exemption Program was implemented by the Board as a vehicle to support economic growth by providing tax exemptions to new and expanding businesses which create jobs in Palm Beach County and provide an economic benefit to the local economy. Pursuant to the Palm Beach County Code, Article VII, Section 17-259, "Economic Development Ad Valorem Tax Exemption," the Board is empowered to revoke the exemption in the event that the company fails to satisfy the conditions set forth in Ordinance No. 2007-006.





16 WHEREAS, on the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County
17 approved and adopted Ordinance 2007-006 on May 15, 2007, entitled "Economic
18 Development Ad Valorem Tax Exemption Ordinance – Florida Turbine Technologies
19 Inc."; and

21 WHEREAS, such Ordinance was adopted pursuant to the authority granted in
22 Article VII, Section 3, of the Constitution of the State of Florida and Section 196.1995
23 Florida Statutes; and
24

25 WHEREAS, Florida Turbine Technologies Inc. failed to file the required annual
26 report by March 2008 and failed to create jobs required; and
27

28 WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2005-004 authorizes the revocation of the Ad
29 Valorem Tax Exemption for failure to file the required annual reports, failure to continue
30 to meet the definition of a new business or an expansion of an existing business, or
31 failure to fulfill any other representation during the application process, and
32

33 WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2007-006 empowers the Board of County
34 Commissioners of Palm Beach County to revoke the exemption granted to Florida
35 Turbine Technologies Inc., in the event Florida Turbine Technologies Inc. fails to satisfy
36 the conditions set forth in such Ordinance.
37

38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
39 COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that;
40

41 SECTION 1. TITLE:

42 This Ordinance shall be known as the "Economic Development Ad Valorem Tax
43 Exemption Ordinance – Florida Turbine Technologies Inc. – Revocation of Exemption".

44 SECTION 2. ENACTMENT AUTHORITY:

45 Ordinance No. 2005-004 empowers the County to revoke Economic
46 Development Ad Valorem Tax Exemptions should any entity awarded an Ad Valorem
47 Tax Exemption fail to file an annual report or any other report required, fail to continue
48 or meet the definition of a new business or an expansion of an existing business, or fail
49 to fulfill any other representation made during the application process.

50 SECTION 3. REVOCATION OF EXEMPTION/RECOVERY OF FUNDS:

51 The Board of County Commissioners hereby revokes the Ad Valorem Tax

1 Exemption granted by Ordinance No. 2007-006. Said revocation shall become effective
2 on January 1, 2007.

3 SECTION 4. REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT:

4 All local laws and ordinances in conflict with any provision of this Ordinance are
5 hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

6 SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY:

7 If any section, paragraph, sentence, cause, phrase, or word of this Ordinance is
8 for any reason held by the Court to be unconstitutional, inoperative, or void, such
9 holding shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.

10 SECTION 6. INCLUSION IN THE CODE OF LAWS AND ORDINANCES:

11 The provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code
12 of Laws and Ordinances of Palm Beach County, Florida. The sections of this Ordinance
13 may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such, and the word "ordinance" may be
14 changed to "section", "article" or other appropriate word.

15 SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE:

16 The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective upon filing with the
17 Department of State, with the effective date of the revocation January 1, 2007.

5 COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA,
6 GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM CERTAIN AD VALOREM
7 TAXATION TO ENCOURAGE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IN
8 THE COUNTY FOR FLORIDA TURBINE TECHNOLOGIES, INC.,
9 AN EXPANSION OF AN EXISTING BUSINESS; PROVIDING
10 FOR A FINDING THAT REQUIREMENTS HAVE BEEN MET;

21 EXEMPTION; PROVIDING FOR ANNUAL REPORTING
22 REQUIREMENT; PROVIDING FOR APPLICABILITY;
23 PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE OF LAWS AND
24 ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING
25 FOR REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING FOR
26 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

29 WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 3, of the Constitution of the State of Florida, and
30 Section 196.1995, Florida Statutes, authorizes the granting of economic development ad
31 valorem tax exemptions to new businesses and expansions of existing businesses upon the
32 successful passage of a referendum; and

33
34 WHEREAS, a successful referendum was held on August 31, 2004, resulting in the
35 enactment of Ordinance No. 2005-004 known as the "Economic Development Ad Valorem
36 Tax Exemption Ordinance of Palm Beach County, Florida"; and

37
38 WHEREAS, such ordinance establishes the requirements for exemption
39 consideration, including the submission of an application; and

40
41 WHEREAS, FLORIDA TURBINE TECHNOLOGIES, INC. has submitted an
42 application for an exemption; and

43
44 WHEREAS, all affected and interested agencies representative of the business and
45 general community have reviewed said application, and provided comments on the granting
46 of same; and

47
48 WHEREAS, all statutory and ordinance requirements have been satisfied.

49
50 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
51 COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

52 SECTION 1. TITLE.

53 This Ordinance shall be known as the "Economic Development Ad Valorem Tax
54 Exemption Ordinance - FLORIDA TURBINE TECHNOLOGIES, INC."

55 SECTION 2. FINDING THAT REQUIREMENTS HAVE BEEN MET.

56 The Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida, based on the
57 application submitted by FLORIDA TURBINE TECHNOLOGIES, INC., and the report of the
58 Property Appraiser, finds that FLORIDA TURBINE TECHNOLOGIES, INC. has met all the
59 requirements of Ordinance No. 2005-004 and meets the requirements of Section 196.012

1 (16), Florida Statutes and that granting the exemption granted hereby will result in an
2 economic benefit to Palm Beach County.

3 SECTION 3. AD VALOREM TAX REVENUES

4 The revenues available to Palm Beach County for the current fiscal year from ad
5 valorem tax sources are \$689,012,361 (operating). The revenues lost to Palm Beach
6 County for the current fiscal year by virtue of the ad valorem tax exemptions currently in
7 effect are \$61,586. The estimated revenues to be lost for 2007 by granting this exemption
8 are estimated to be \$26,153.

9 SECTION 4. TERM OF EXEMPTION; EXPIRATION DATE.

10 The Economic Development Ad Valorem Tax Exemption granted to FLORIDA
11 TURBINE TECHNOLOGIES, INC. for an expansion of an existing business shall be for a
12 period of four (4) tax years commencing on January 1, 2007 and expiring on December 31,
13 2010. The ability to receive an exemption for the period granted is conditioned upon
14 FLORIDA TURBINE TECHNOLOGIES, INC.'s ability to maintain the expansion of an
15 existing business as defined in Ordinance No. 2005-004 throughout the four (4) year
16 exemption period. FLORIDA TURBINE TECHNOLOGIES, INC. shall submit an annual
17 report to the Board of County Commissioners evidencing satisfaction of this condition in
18 such form as attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "B." FLORIDA TURBINE
19 TECHNOLOGIES, INC. shall furnish any and all information as the Board of County
20 Commissioners or its designee deems necessary for the purpose of determining continued
21 performance of the imposed conditions. Should FLORIDA TURBINE TECHNOLOGIES,
22 INC. fail to satisfy the conditions set forth herein, the Board of County Commissioners may
23 revoke the exemption and recover any taxes waived pursuant to Section 9 of Ordinance No.
24 2005-004.

25 SECTION 5. GRANT OF EXEMPTION.

26 After consideration of the application submitted by FLORIDA TURBINE
27 TECHNOLOGIES, INC., a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as
28 Exhibit "B", which includes the report of the Property Appraiser, in accordance with the
29 procedure set forth in Ordinance No. 2005-004, the Board of County Commissioners hereby
30 grants and establishes an exemption from ad valorem taxation of one hundred per cent
31 (100%) of the assessed value of the net increase in qualifying tangible personal property
32 acquired and added improvements to real property by FLORIDA TURBINE
33 TECHNOLOGIES, INC. after the adoption of this Ordinance, provided such net increase in

1 qualifying tangible personal property and real property facilitate FLORIDA TURBINE
2 TECHNOLOGIES, INC.'s expansion of an existing business located at 100 Marquette
3 Road, Jupiter, Florida, 33458. FLORIDA TURBINE TECHNOLOGIES, INC. agrees to abide
4 by the terms and conditions set forth in Ordinance No. 2005-004 and any and all
5 amendments thereto, as well as any policies and procedures related to the Economic
6 Development Ad Valorem Tax Exemption Program as may be adopted from time to time.
7 Failure to abide by same may result in a revocation of the exemption and the recovery of
8 any taxes waived pursuant to Section 9 of Ordinance No. 2005-004. No exemption shall be
9 granted on the land on which improvements for the expansion of an existing business are
10 made by FLORIDA TURBINE TECHNOLOGIES, INC.

11 SECTION 6. APPLICABILITY.

12 The exemption applies only to taxes levied by Palm Beach County. The exemption
13 does not apply to taxes levied by a municipality, school district, or water management
14 district, or to taxes levied for the payment of bonds or taxes authorized by a vote of the
15 electors pursuant to Section 9 and Section 12, Article VII of the State Constitution.

16 SECTION 7. INCLUSION IN THE CODE OF LAWS AND ORDINANCES.

17 The provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of
18 Laws and Ordinances of Palm Beach County, Florida. The sections of this Ordinance may
19 be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such, and the word "Ordinance" may be
20 changed to "Section", "Article", or any other appropriate word.

21 SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY.

22 If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Ordinance is for
23 any reason held by a Court to be unconstitutional, inoperative or void, such holding shall not
24 affect the remainder of this Ordinance.

25 SECTION 9. REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT.

26 All local ordinances in conflict with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby
27 repealed to the extent of such conflict.

28 SECTION 10. EFFECTIVE DATE.

29 The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective upon filing with the
30 Department of State.
