

10 WHEREAS, a viable regional transportation system is vitally important to the City of  
11 Boca Raton and the tri-county area; and

12 WHEREAS, Tri-Rail ridership continues to grow, serving more than 15,000 people per

14 WHEREAS, Tri-Rail is an important element in the South Florida Regional  
15 Transportation Authority's mission to implement a regional transportation system in order to  
16 provide greater mobility, improve economic viability and enhance the quality of life in South  
17 Florida; now therefore  
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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOCA

RATON:

Section 1. Palm Beach, Broward and Miami-Dade Counties are hereby urged to increase, or maintain at current levels, their funding of the South Florida Regional Transportation Authority.

Section 2. A copy of this resolution shall be delivered to the Board of Commissioners of Palm Beach, Broward and Miami-Dade counties.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, clause or provision of this resolution is held invalid, the remainder shall not be affected by such invalidity.


Section 4. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith shall be and hereby are repealed.


Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
