I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Amendment No. 4 to the contract with Moss & Associates, LLC (R2007-0031) for construction management services for the out buildings at the West County Detention Facility for a Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) in the amount of \$18,819,143, subject to the closing on the Criminal Justice and Public Improvement Revenue Bonds, Series 2008 on August 27, 2008.



Summary: In November 2007 (R2007-1973) and February 2008 (R2008-0199), the Board approved amendments which authorized the demucking and installation of site utilities for the first phase of the Jail Expansion Program 2 – West County Detention Facility. This work is underway. Amendment No. 4 will provide for the construction of a new Eagle Academy building, fuel station, impound building and renovations to the existing Eagle Academy building for its intended inmate population. This work needs to start prior to the primary detention center building to allow for relocation of existing programs and demo of buildings in the footprint of the expanded detention center. Associated site work is included such as paving, landscaping, irrigation, site lighting, and utility connections. The SBE goal for this project is 15%. Moss & Associates will be providing 19.2% SBE participation in this amendment. The duration of this work is 352 calendar days (Capital Improvements Division) Countywide (JM)

Background and Justification: On April 15, 2006, the Board approved proceeding with the Jail Expansion Program II consisting of the expansion of the West County Detention Facility and the Stockade and renovations to the Main Detention Facility. On November 6, 2007, the Board approved Amendment No. 1 to demuck and fill the site and on February 5, 2008 the Board approved Amendment No. 2 to provide site utilities. Demucking and site utilities work previously authorized is ongoing and will occur concurrently with the work contained in this amendment. This Amendment is the next phase of work required in the development of the West County Jail project.

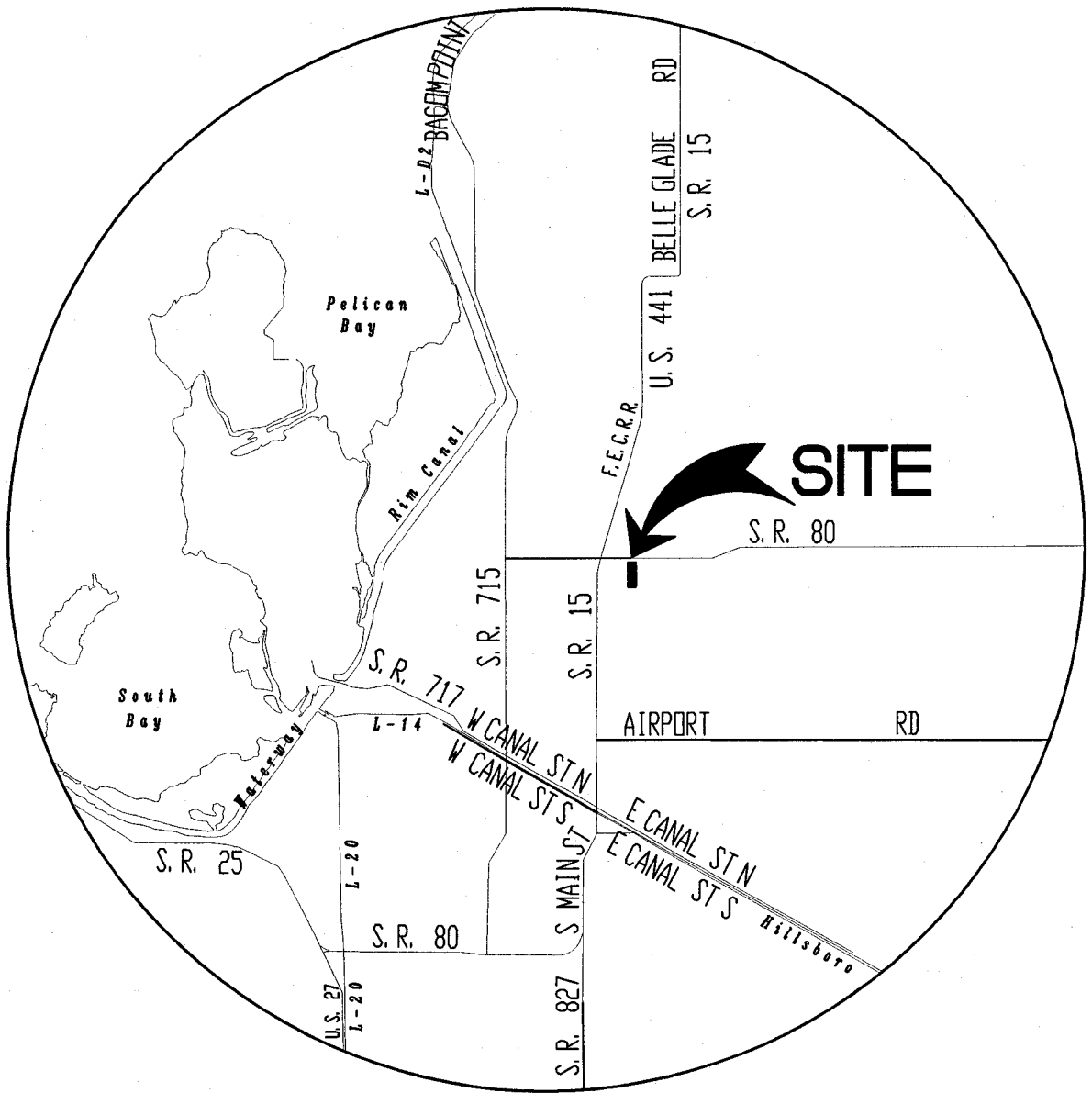

**AMENDMENT # 4 TO CONTRACT FOR
CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES
JAIL EXPANSION PROGRAM II
WEST COUNTY JAIL
PROJECT NO. 06213**

WHEREAS, the Owner and Construction Manager, Moss & Associates, LLC, acknowledge and agree that the Contract between Owner and Construction Manager is in full force and effect and that this Amendment merely supplements said Contract;

WHEREAS, the parties hereto entered into a Contract between Owner and Construction Manager whereby the Construction Manager has rendered or will render construction services as specified therein; and

WHEREAS, the parties have negotiated a Guaranteed Maximum Price, including Construction Managers fees for construction and warranty services and other services as set forth herein and in the Contract;

NOW THEREFORE, in exchange for the mutual covenants and promises set forth herein and the sums of money agreed to be paid by the Owner to the Construction Manager, the parties agree as follows:

(1) **GUARANTEED MAXIMUM PRICE**

Pursuant to Article 2.2 and Article 6 of the Contract between Owner and Construction Manager, the parties have agreed to the establishment of a Guaranteed Maximum Price of **\$18,819,143** for the construction cost of constructing Eagle Academy, Impound Building, Drug Farm and Fuel Station as described in the GMP Proposal dated July 10, 2008 for the West County Detention Facility. Refer to Exhibit "A".

(2) **SCHEDULE OF TIME FOR COMPLETION**

Pursuant to Article 5.3, Construction Manager shall substantially complete this work within **Three Hundred Fifty Two (352)** calendar days of receiving the Notice to Proceed. Should the Contractor (or in the event of a default, its Surety) fail to achieve certification of Substantial Completion by the Contractual end date, the County will suffer damages, the amount of which is difficult if not impossible to ascertain, and the County shall be entitled to Liquidated Damages as specified for each calendar day beyond the Contractual end date, until certification of Substantial Completion and acceptance has been given by the County. The Liquidated Damages rate is **\$770.00** per day through the date certification of Substantial Completion.
