I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to adopt: Resolution delegating authority to the County Administrator, or his designee, to sign the Fiscal Year 2009 HIV Emergency Relief Grant Application and any other necessary documents.

Summary: The County has been notified that, as an Eligible Metropolitan Area (EMA) we will receive funds under the Part A HIV Emergency Relief Grant. The grant application for FY 2009 must be submitted to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services by September 29, 2008. The grant application will be completed by the 19th of September, but still must be reviewed by the HIV CARE Council staff and the Community Services Department. To ensure that the grant application deadline is met, the delegation of authority to sign the application is requested. <u>Countywide</u> (TKF)

Background and Justification: Designated EMAs are those communities which as of March 31, 1993, reported to and had confirmed by the Center for Disease Control (CDC), a cumulative total of more than 2,000 cases of AIDS within the EMA, or that had a per capita incidence of cumulative cases of AIDS equal to or exceeding 0.0025.

Part A funds provide direct financial assistance to EMAs most severely affected by the HIV epidemic. The purpose of the funds is to deliver or enhance HIV related outpatient and ambulatory health and support services, including case management and comprehensive treatment services for individuals and families with HIV disease.

The goal is to provide support to, and to augment, the urban health care systems currently bearing the overwhelming burden of providing HIV-related care, by assisting EMAs to operate programs that provide an appropriate continuum of outpatient and ambulatory health care and support services. Funding priorities must be established by the designated Part A HIV Health Services Planning Council based upon an assessment of the service of all affected populations within the EMA.

Since streamlining of the agenda process has increased the length of time between Board meetings and, it is imperative that the application be executed timely, the Department is requesting that the Board delegate authority to the County Administrator or his designee to sign the grant application.
