I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

- A) A \$21,837.26 Task Agreement to the Municipal Service Taxing Unit (MSTU) Districts "A through E" Annual Engineering Agreement with Civil Design, Inc. (CDI) for engineering, surveying, and permitting services for design and construction plans for 'A' Street paving and drainage improvements, Project Number 2006132; and
- **B)** A Budget Transfer of \$27,338 in the MSTU District C Fund from Reserves to 'A' Street, from Kirk Road to its eastern terminus prior to Corrigan Court.

SUMMARY: Approval of the Budget Transfer will provide funds for CDI to perform engineering, surveying, and permitting services for design and construction plans for 'A' Street, from its western terminus at Kirk Road to its eastern terminus prior to Corrigan Court, paving and drainage improvements.

District 3, MSTU District C. (MRE)

Background and Justification: It is necessary for CDI to perform engineering, surveying and permitting services under the MSTU Districts "A through E" Engineering Services Annual Agreement, approved by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) on April 10, 2007, by Resolution No. R-2007-0462, and the Renewal Agreement dated March 11, 2008, by Resolution No. R-2008-0310. The services consist of paving and drainage design and construction plans for the 'A' Street paving and drainage improvements (Project). The Budget Transfer will fund the consultant services on the Project.

Staff recommends that the BCC approve the attached Task Agreement.



WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the COUNTY and the CONSULTANT entered into an Annual Agreement on April 10, 2007 (R-2007-0462)/Renewal dated March 11, 2008 (R-2008-0310), whereby the CONSULTANT was retained to furnish certain professional services required for MSTU Districts "A" through "E" on an annual basis. It is now necessary to acquire engineering, surveying, and permitting services for the A Street Paving and Drainage Improvement Project, MSTU District 'C', Palm Beach County, Florida (hereinafter called the PROJECT); and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY now desires the CONSULTANT to perform engineering services for the PROJECT; and

RE: A STREET PAVING AND DRAINAGE PROJECT, M.S.T.U. DISTRICT "C"

WHEREAS, the following fees have been negotiated and found to be reasonable and just compensation for the professional services to be performed by the CONSULTANT: Basic Services: a lump sum fee of \$15,661.26 for engineering and permit services; Additional Services: a lump sum fee of \$5,076.00 for surveying services to be performed by Keshavarz & Associates, Inc., and; Reimbursable Expenses: a lump sum fee of \$1,100.00 for permit application and governmental fees, totaling \$21,837.26, as outlined in the proposal package dated August 5, 2008, attached hereto as a part of Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the mutual benefits to flow from each to the other, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. The CONSULTANT agrees to provide professional services as described in Exhibit "A" of the Agreement known as "SCOPE OF WORK".
- 2. The CONSULTANT agrees to "CERTIFICATION STATEMENTS" as described in Exhibit "B" of the Agreement.
- 3. The CONSULTANT agrees to SMALL BUSINESS/MINORITY/WOMEN BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (S/M/WBE) PARTICIPATION as described in Exhibit "C" of the Agreement.
- 4. The LETTER(S) OF INTENT to perform as a SBE/MBE/WBE and/or sub-consultant as described in Exhibit "D" of the Agreement.
- The CONFLICT OF INTEREST DISCLOSURE FORM as described in Exhibit "E" of the Agreement.
- 6. The COUNTY agrees to pay the CONSULTANT a fee of Twenty One Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty Seven and 26/100 Dollars.
- 7. The CONSULTANT agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the COUNTY against all claims that may arise as a result of negligence, wrongdoing, misconduct or want of care by the CONSULTANT.

Except as hereby amended, changed or modified, all other terms and conditions of the original Agreement dated April 10, 2007 (R-2007-0462)/Renewal dated March 11, 2008 (R-2008-0310), and;

Supplements and Amendments thereto, shall remain in full force and effect.

Dear Mr. Marquis:

Pursuant to our discussions, please find below a task list and lump sum fee proposal for the subject work to be performed under our annual contract for MSTU engineering services with Palm Beach County (PBC).

Project Description:

Project consists of the surveying, design and permitting of approximately 600 linear feet of roadway and drainage improvements along A Street from its west terminus at Kirk Road to its east terminus prior to Corrigan Drive.

Basis of Scope & Scope of Services (by Task and Activity):

<u>Task 1</u> includes field survey of the project by our subconsultant Keshavarz & Associates, Inc. Work includes the following:

- 1. Establish the base line control and identify stationing.
- Stations will be set at 100 foot intervals.
- Obtain location of first catch basin north of A Street and first catch basin south of A Street depicting rims, inverts and pipe sizes.
- 4. The survey will contain vertical control pursuant to 3rd order level circuit based on Palm Beach County's Vertical Control Network.
- 5. Cross sections will be obtained at each property line, but not more than 100 foot intervals, and will include up to 20 feet on either side of the right-of-way. Seven total cross sections are assumed.
- 6. Topography will be obtained and project tie-in will be performed.
- Reference control points will be set for horizontal and vertical control for construction plans.

<u>Task 2</u> includes engineering design services required to produce construction plans ready for permitting by those Authorities Having Jurisdiction (AHJ's) over the project. This task includes the following:

- 1. Consultant will coordinate the work of its subconsultant and attend meetings with Palm Beach County staff to review plans at each submittal stage. Up to three meetings are anticipated in this activity.
- Consultant will make one site visit to verify existing conditions.
- Consultant will coordinate utilities will add franchise utility information to drawings as provided by the respective utility so that conflicts can be coordinated and minimized.

- 4. Consultant will prepare a cover sheet for the project plan set that will include project location map, governing standard references, index, legend, project length and engineer's certification. One sheet is anticipated for this activity.
- Typical section/detail sheets will be prepared to include a typical road section for the road improvements and applicable Palm Beach County details. Two sheets are anticipated for this activity.
- A specification and quantity sheet, including summary of quantities, will be prepared. Activity
 includes preparing a plan take-off of quantities to complete the summary of pay items table. One
 sheet is anticipated for this activity.
- 7. Plan and profiles sheets will be prepared identifying the proposed improvements. Plans will include up to 600 linear feet each (6 stations) and are expected to be prepared at 1"=20' for 24"x36" plans sheets. Two sheets are anticipated for this activity.
- 8. A construction control sheet will be prepared depicting the survey reference data by station, offset, description and elevation. One sheet is anticipated for this activity.
- An engineer's opinion of probable construction costs will be prepared utilizing the summary of quantities obtained form the design plans and recent bid unit price information.

<u>Task 3</u> includes permitting services required to produce construction plans ready for construction by those Authorities Having Jurisdiction (AHJ's) over the project. Consultant will respond to usual and customary requests for additional information from these AHJ's. This task includes the following:

- 1. Plans and calculations approval is anticipated to be approved under the south Florida Water Management District "No-Notice" General Environmental Resource permit criteria. There is a \$100 permit fee for this permit application.
- 2. The site is within the limits of the Lake Worth Drainage District and as such, a permit application will not be submitted. There is a \$1,000 fee for this permit application.

Project Schedule:

It is anticipated that the survey (Task 1) can be completed within 30 days of the Notice to Proceed (NTP) and that plan preparation (Task 2) can be completed within 90 days thereafter (120 days from NTP). Permitting (Task 3) is anticipated to take 90 days after completion of Task 2, however, the approval of permit applications is outside the Consultant's control.

- 1. Survey work will be subcontracted to Keshavarz & Associates, Inc.
- 2. Plan submittals will be prepared and submitted at the 35%, 65% and 100% stages for PBC review.
- 3. Design is based on providing water quality in roadside swales with raised inlets and driveways.
- 4. There are no offsite improvements (i.e. upsizing existing facilities) anticipated in this Agreement.
- 5. Details sufficient to construct the project will be referenced or provided on the plans. Therefore, preparation of technical specifications is not included in this scope of services.
- Construction observation services are not included in this scope of services.
- Project will be billed as completed through the billing period at each deliverable stage. The attached lump sum fee proposal is provided for information and the rates are based on our approved PBC MSTU annual agreement.
- 8. In the event that SFWMD determined that project does not comply with the No-Notice permit criteria, additional permitting fees will be required to apply for a different permit.

If the above, and the attached spreadsheet, meet with your approval, we are ready to commence work on this project upon your notice to proceed. Please do not hesitate to contact me with any questions.
