#### **I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF**

**Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:** First Amendment to Interlocal Agreement (R2005-1552) with the City of West Palm Beach for funding of the Grassy Waters Preserve Visitors Pavilion project.

**Summary:** This Amendment extends the project completion date for the Grassy Waters Preserve Visitors Pavilion project from August 15, 2008, to April 15, 2010, in order to allow for additional time for project completion and submission of reimbursement documentation to the County. All other terms of the Agreement, including the funding amount of \$250,000, remain the same. Funding for the project is from the 2002 \$50 Million Cultural and Recreational Facilities Bond referendum - District 2 and District 6. <u>District 6</u> (PK)

**Background and Justification:** On August 16, 2005, the County entered into an Interlocal Agreement with the City of West Palm Beach in an amount not-to-exceed \$250,000 for the design and construction of a Visitors Pavilion at the Grassy Waters Preserve. Project elements include the visitors pavilion, a boardwalk, interpretive signs, native landscaping and amenities, and other miscellaneous site improvements. The Visitors Center will serve as a demonstration/educational building, entry, and welcome center on the south side of the Grassy Waters Preserve. The delay in project completion is due to the design's utilization of Florida Green Building recommendations, which required a lengthy certification process for Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Green Building Rating System designation. The extension of the project completion date until April 15, 2010, will allow sufficient time to accommodate the design delays, subsequent project construction, and the reimbursement process. All other terms of the Agreement remain the same.

The Amendment has been executed by the City of West Palm Beach, and now needs to be approved by the Board of County Commissioners.

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#### Res 440-09 FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY AND THE CITY OF WEST PALM BEACH FOR FUNDING OF GRASSY WATERS PRESERVE VISITORS PAVILION PROJECT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT (R-2005-1552) is entered into on \_\_\_\_\_\_, by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY", and the City of West Palm Beach, a corporate body politic pursuant to the Constitution of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "MUNICIPALITY".

#### WITNESSETH:

August WHEREAS, on October 16, 2005, COUNTY entered into an Agreement with MUNICIPALITY ( R-2005-1552) to provide funding in an amount not-to-exceed \$250,000 for funding of the Grassy Waters Preserve Pavilion Project for the period October 16, 2005, through October 15, 2008; and August

WHEREAS, MUNICIPALITY has requested a time extension of the Agreement until April 15, 2010, to complete construction of the Grassy Waters Preserve – Phase I; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY desires to allow for additional project completion time for construction of said project, which will benefit all citizens of Palm Beach County;

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Agreement.

**NOW THEREFORE,** the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. Section 2.06 of the Agreement shall be amended by <u>deleting</u> "thirty six (36) months from the date of execution of this Agreement by the parties hereto and <u>inserting</u> "until April 15, 2010" in its place.

2. Except as provided herein, each and every other term of the Agreement, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect and the Agreement is reaffirmed as modified herein.
