FIRST AMENDMENT TO LEGAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT, dated this ___ day of December 2008, to the Agreement (R2008-0444) of March 11, 2008, by and between PALM BEACH COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, and the Office of the Public Defender, Fifteenth Judicial Circuit, a Florida Constitutional Officer, hereinafter referred to as OFFICE.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties have entered into the Agreement of March 11, 2008 under which the OFFICE agreed to operate a pilot project in the Ex-Offender Re-Entry Program for Florida identification cards for newly released inmates from the county jail; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY agreed to reimburse the OFFICE from the local Crime Prevention Trust Fund (CPTF) for operating expenses and supplies; and

WHEREAS, the term of said Agreement is from January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the parties mutually desire to extend the Agreement for an additional nine months, until September 30, 2009.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreement expressed herein, the COUNTY and OFFICE agree as follows:

- 1. The term of Agreement is amended to provide that the Agreement shall continue until September 30, 2009.
- 2. The total amount to be paid by the COUNTY for all services for the period January 1, 2009 through September 30, 2009 under this Agreement shall not exceed Seven Thousand Dollars (\$7,000) from the COUNTY'S Crime Prevention Trust Funds.
- 3. Both the COUNTY and the OFFICE agree to be governed by this Agreement, as well as applicable State laws, rules and regulations.
- 4. Modification of this Agreement may be requested by either party. Changes which are mutually agreed upon shall be valid only when reduced to writing, duly signed by each party and attached to the original Agreement.

In accordance with Palm Beach County Code, Chapter 2, Article III, Section 2.51., this First Amendment shall not take effect until executed by the OFFICE and COUNTY.
