The County has encumbered \$799,739 (\$53,316/month) during the previous fifteen (15) months of the current eighteen (18) month term contract. Based upon historical usage, the addition of Basic Life Support transport service in certain geographical response zones, and an increase in emergency transport rates, Fire-Rescue anticipates generating \$46,896,046 in revenue during this forty-two (42) month new term contract. The contractor will be paid 5.3% of non-Medicaid gross monthly collections, which is estimated to be a total of \$2,485,490 (\$59,178/month). This is a .85% decrease in the percent of non-Medicaid gross monthly collection to be paid to contractor and no annual flat fee to be paid to the contractor for Medicaid collections. This contract has one (1) twelve (12) month renewal option. This contract was established by a competitive RFP process that allowed up to ten (10) points for SBE participation. No certified SBE participation was
