#### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Consultant Services Authorization (CSA) No. 7 to the contract (2007-0033) with Hellmuth, Obata & Kassabaum, Inc. (HOK) in the amount of \$1,001,595 for the construction administration services on the West County Detention Center.

Summary: At the February 24, 2009 BCC meeting, construction of the West County Detention Facility was approved. CSA No. 7 will authorize construction administration services of the design professional for the West County Detention Center Facility. CSA No. 7 is funded from the Criminal Justice and Public Improvement Revenue Bond Series 2008. The SBE goal for this project is 15%. CSA No. 7 includes 5.8% participation. When combined with the previous work done under this contract, the SBE participation is 18.7% (Capital Improvements Division) Countywide/District 6 (JM)

Background and Justification: On April 25, 2006, the Board approved proceeding with the Jail Expansion Program II consisting of the expansion of the West County Detention Facility, Stockade and renovations to the Main Detention Center at an estimated cost of \$267 million. The Board approved CSA No. 1 with Hellmuth, Obata & Kassabaum (HOK) on June 5, 2007, for early site packages, permitting, out buildings and 20% construction documents for the Jail Expansion. On December 18, 2007, the Board approved CSA No. 3 for the balance of the design services and construction administration for the out buildings and design and construction administration for Central Video Visitation. This CSA is the for the construction administration services for the West County Jail Expansion. Together, HOK/STH has received \$5,580,126 in design fees for the Phase I of JEP2.


