## AMENDMENT #4 TO ANNUAL PAVILION CONTRACT

This agreement amends the contract between Palm Beach County (County) and S&F Construction, Inc., (Contractor) authorized pursuant to Palm Beach County Resolution (R-2005-1871).

The original contract provided that Contractor would act as an annual pavilion contractor from September 27, 2005 to September 26, 2006 or until Contractor had been awarded projects totaling four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000), whichever occurred first. That contract also provides that it could be extended for four additional terms. This is the fourth and final amendment. This contract was previously amended on October 3, 2006 and August 21, 2007 and on May 6, 2008.

The County is extending the contract for a period of twelve (12) months based on the pending work which would exceed the value assigned to the contract. The total dollar value limit for each term is four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000). Pursuant to the provisions of the existing contract, the parties agree that Contractor will continue to act as an annual general contractor until March 16, 2010 or until the total dollar value of work authorizations for the fifth term totals four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000), whichever comes first. The parties agree that the total dollar value of work authorizations issued pursuant to this amendment shall not exceed four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000).

Except as amended herein, all provisions of the existing contract shall remain in full force and effect.
