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RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, TO REDUCE YOUTH SMOKING AND IMPROVE THE HEALTH OF FLORIDA CITIZENS.

WHEREAS, every year 22,500 new Florida children become addicted to tobacco and more than one-third of them will die prematurely because of this addiction; and

WHEREAS, 90 percent of all adult smokers surveyed admitted they started smoking during their teenage years; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida spends \$1.2 Billion a year in Medicaid dollars on smoking related illnesses, while receiving approximately \$400 Million in cigarette tax revenue; and

WHEREAS, the annual overall cost of health care for smokers in Florida, including private insurance costs, is estimated at over \$6.3 Billion a year; and

WHEREAS, Florida's 34-cent Cigarette Excise Tax is one of the lowest in the United States and has not been raised in nearly two decades; and

WHEREAS, increasing Florida's Cigarette Excise Tax by \$1.00 would reduce the number of youth that smoke by 16.3 percent and significantly reduce the amount of adults who smoke, save \$3.8 Billion in long-term health care costs, and provide nearly \$631 Million in additional state revenues annually to cover rising health care costs; and

WHEREAS, reduced State budget revenues threaten established programs to provide health insurance and health care services for the most vulnerable Floridians and provide no opportunity for expansion of programs and services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA does hereby support increasing the Cigarette Excise Tax in Florida by \$1.00 per pack, which will reduce smoking, especially among children and fund critical health care priorities such as medically needy insurance, emergency room care, disease prevention, and medical research.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a suitable copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the Palm Beach County Legislative Delegation Chair in Tallahassee, and to the Speaker of the Florida House, Senate President, and to the Governor.
