WHEREAS, the City has applied to the Board to use the truck for the purposes of promoting the public or community interest and welfare, and the Board is satisfied that the Chevy Blazer is required for such purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the Chevy Blazer will be used for the public or community interest and welfare as described herein, and that the Chevy Blazer should be conveyed for the nominal sum of one dollar (\$1:00) and other good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:
