## I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: A) ratify the Chairman's signature on a South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) Indian River Lagoon License Plate grant application submitted for the Carlin Park Sanitary Sewer Project; B) authorize the County Administrator or his designee to execute the grant project agreement, time extensions, task assignments, certifications, standard forms, or amendments to the agreement that do not change the scope of work or terms and conditions of the agreement, if the grant is approved; and C) authorize the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department to serve as Liaison Agent with the SFWMD for this project.

**Summary:** This Grant Application requests \$65,975 from SFWMD Indian River Lagoon License Plate grant funding for the Carlin Park Sanitary Sewer Project. Project elements include connecting four restrooms to public sanitary sewer and abandoning three septic tanks. The project is necessary because the County is in the process of constructing a performing arts amphitheater in Carlin Park and The Town of Jupiter required that the restrooms be connected to the public sanitary sewer system within five years as condition of approval for the amphitheater project. <u>District 1</u> (AH)

Background and Justification: The sale of Indian River Lagoon license plates helps fund environmental projects that benefit the Indian River and/or Loxahatchee watershed in Palm Beach, Martin and St. Lucie counties. SFWMD's time frame for this application did not allow for prior approval by the Board of County Commissioners. In order to meet the grant application submission deadline, on February 25, 2009, Commissioner Jeff Koons, Chairman, signed the application on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners, as authorized by PPM CW-F-003 (Policy B.3). The PPM requires that the grant be presented to the Board of County Commissioners for approval at the next available Board meeting after signature by the Board Chairperson.

Indian River Lagoon License Plate funding is available for environmental projects benefitting the Indian River and/or Loxahatchee watershed. Converting the Carlin Park restrooms from septic tanks to public sanitary sewer will have a positive impact on the quality of the water in the tidal creek running from Carlin Park north to the Jupiter Inlet. The total project cost identified in this grant application is \$346,400. The requested grant is for \$65,975 and will be matched with \$280,425 in Zone One Impact Fees.

Palm Beach County respectfully requests your consideration of the attached grant application for funding from the South Florida Water Management District's Indian River Lagoon License Plate Funding Program. The County is requesting funding in the amount of \$65,975 for the Carlin Park Sanitary Sewer project, this request represents (30%) of the total construction cost of \$219,900. The cost of the entire project including design, geotechnical, survey, and permitting fees is \$346,400. A construction bid is in the process of being negotiated and environmental and construction permits are expected to be issued by the end of March 2009.

The proposed project is located in Carlin Park, a waterfront park in northern Palm Beach County. The project will convert four restrooms from septic tank to sanitary sewer. The septic tanks range in age from 15 to 30 years old. Abandoning the septic tanks will improve water quality in the Loxahatchee Watershed by eliminating septic tank effluent with nitrogen and phosphorus from entering the tidal creek which runs north to the Loxahatchee River at the mouth of the Jupiter Inlet.

The scope of work for the project consists of the following:

- Construction of three new lift stations
- Connecting four restrooms to public sanitary sewer
- Abandoning three septic tanks

# Exhibit "A" STATEMENT OF WORK

#### 1.0 INTRODUCTION

Carlin Park is a 118-acre waterfront park located in northern Palm Beach County on the barrier island between the Atlantic Ocean and the Intracoastal Waterway. Carlin Park features 3,000 feet of guarded beach, athletic fields, tennis courts, playgrounds, picnic facilities, and restrooms. A performing arts amphitheater is under construction. The public sewer project and exotic vegetation removal and replanting 12.55-acres with native species is part of the larger performing arts amphitheater project.

The proposed project includes converting four restrooms from septic tanks to public sanitary sewer. This project will benefit the Indian River Lagoon by improving water quality in the Loxahatchee River, and the Loxahatchee Watershed. Since the septic tanks range in age from 15 to 30 years old and are on the tidal creek which runs from Carlin Park to the Loxahatchee River at the mouth of the Jupiter Inlet. The potential for leakage of septic effluent into the water column is a serious concern. This is an oceanfront park subject to tidal surges and flooding during hurricanes.

## 2.0 BENEFITS TO THE INDIAN RIVER LAGOON

This project is expected to benefit the Indian River Lagoon primarily by enhancing the overall viability of the ecosystem by improving water quality by preventing leakage of septic effluent into the Loxahatchee Watershed and into the tidal creek which flows into the Loxahatchee River at the mouth of the Jupiter Inlet.

#### 3.0 PROJECT LOCATION

The project is located at Carlin Park, 400 S.R. A-1-A, Jupiter, FL 33477. This park is located on the east side of the Intracoastal Waterway in northern Palm Beach County, just south of the Jupiter Inlet. The project is located on the Loxahatchee Watershed. Please see attached map.

### 4.0 SCOPE OF WORK

The project includes connecting four restrooms to public sanitary sewer and building three lift stations. The design, geotechnical, and survey work have already been completed. Permit applications have been submitted to the Loxahatchee River Improvement District (ENCON), Town of Jupiter Engineering Department, Palm Beach County Health Department, and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection. All environmental permits are expected to be issued be the end of March 2009. The Palm Beach County Capital Facilities Division will manage the project on behalf of the Palm Beach County Parks and Recreation Department.

# **5.0 WORK BREAKDOWN STRUCTURE**

All work will be performed by a contractor, who will be responsible for providing all labor, equipment, and supplies. Every effort will be made by the contractor to avoid damage to native vegetation and wildlife. This work will be strictly monitored by The County's Capital Improvement Division, which will ensure that no collateral damage is inflicted in this ecologically sensitive area.

Work is expected to commence in the spring or summer of 2009 and to take approximately five months to complete.

## **FUNDING PROPOSAL**

The Parks and Recreation Department is requesting \$65,975 in grant funding from the Indian River Lagoon License Plate tag Fund. This represents 19% of the total project cost and 30% of the actual construction cost.

The total cost of the project including construction plans, specifications, survey work, geotechnical work, permit and utilities fees, management, contingency fees and construction is \$346,400. Many of these items have already been completed and funds expended.

The cost of the actual construction including electrical work is \$219,900.

Several funding sources are being used for this project including, monies from the 2003 \$25 Million General Obligation Parks and Cultural Facilities Bond, monies from the 2005 \$25 Million General Obligation Parks and Cultural Facilities Bond, and impact fees.
