Background and Justification: Chapter 77-616, as amended, provides for the organization of the Environmental Control Hearing Board. This Special Act states that the composition of this Board shall consist of an attorney, a doctor, an engineer, and two citizens. Palm Beach County Resolution 92-123 establishes the terms for the members of the Environmental Control Hearing Board. Lewis Green expressed a desire to remain on the Hearing Board and was recommended by the Palm Beach County Medical Society.

 - (1) The lawyer, engineer, and two citizens shall serve for one (1) year.
 - (2) The medical doctor shall serve for two
 - (3) Thereafter, all appointments shall be made for a term of three (3) years. Appointments to fill any vacancy on the Hearing Board shall be for the remainder of the unexpired term of office.
 - (4) Members of the Hearing Board shall be automatically removed for lack of attendance. Lack of attendance is defined as failure to attend three (3) consecutive meetings or failure to attend more than one-half of the meetings scheduled during a calendar year. Participation for less than three-fourths of a meeting shall constitute lack of attendance. Excused absences due to illness, absence from the County, or personal hardship shall not constitute lack of attendance.
