I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to adopt: Α Resolution vacating a portion of a 12 foot wide Utility Easement within Lot 20, Thornhill Green, as recorded in Plat Book 36, Pages 125, Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida.

SUMMARY: This petition site is located west of Powerline Road and south of Palmetto Park Road on the south side of Arcadia Court. The petitioner is requesting the vacation to accommodate an addition to their house.

Background and Justification: The owners, Amiel Tokayer and Edna Tokayer, want to construct an addition to their home. In order to accommodate the addition, it is necessary to vacate a portion of the 12 foot wide utility easement along the south property line.

Utilities service providers have no objection to the vacation.

Utility Easements are exempt from the privilege fee requirement in accordance with the Palm Beach County Right-of-Way Abandonment and Plat Vacation Ordinance 86-18, as amended.


