I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: A) budget transfer of \$157,885 within the \$25M GO Parks and Cultural Improvements Bond Fund - 2005 from Neighborhood Parks to the Mangonia Park 53rd Street Park and Baseball Field lighting project; and B) budget transfer of \$44,353 from the 1999 Recreation and Cultural Facilities Bond Riviera Beach Northwest Community Center to the Mangonia Park 53rd Street Park and Baseball Field lighting project.

Summary: These budget transfers provide funding for the construction of lighting facilities at the Mangonia Park 53rd Street Park and Baseball Field. Funding is from the 2002 \$50M Recreation and Cultural Bond's District 7 Neighborhood Parks remaining balance and the 1999 \$50M Recreation and Cultural Facilities Bond's unexpended balance for the completed Riviera Beach Northwest Park Community Center project. The District 7 Commissioner supports these transfers totaling \$202,238. District 7 (PK)

Background and Policy Issues: The District 7 Commissioner has identified funding totaling \$202,238 from District 7 Neighborhood Park from the 2002 Recreation and Cultural Facilities Bond (\$157,885) and from the 1999 Recreation and Cultural Facilities Bond - Riviera Beach Northwest Community Center project unexpended balance (\$44,353). The Commissioner wishes to combine these two funding sources for a park and ballfield lighting project at Mangonia Park's 53rd Street Park, and has requested that the Board approve the above budget transfers for this project. Usage of the 53rd Street Park and Baseball Field is not restricted to residents only.

This lighting project will enhance the safety and security of the baseball field and park as well as allowing for extended play time at the baseball fields. The \$202,238 provided from the 1999 and 2002 Recreation and Cultural Facilities bonds will fund the project cost. Upon approval of these budget transfers by the Board, staff will prepare the required Interlocal Agreement for the \$202,238 in Bond Funding for the Mangonia Park 53rd Street Park and Baseball Field lighting project and will place it on a subsequent Agenda for Board approval.

I was informed by my Administrative Assistant, Shirley Meeks ,that the funding of the Town of Mangonia Park 53rd Street Park and Baseball Field lighting project, agenda item 3-C-11 that was placed on the agenda for April 21, 2009 could not be paid from the District Transportation Improvement fund due to the fact that the lighting is to be installed at a recreational facility. Upon request, Susan Yinger informed our office that we had a total of \$202,238 of unallocated bond money. 1999 Recreation and Cultural Facilities Bond funds in the amount of \$44,353, (unexpended balance from the Northwest Park Development Project), and 2002 Recreation and Cultural Facilities Bond funds in the amount of \$157,885.

Please allow this correspondence to serve as confirmation that I would like to allocate the total amount of these unexpended funds, \$202,238, to the Town of Mangonia Park for the 53rd Street Park and Baseball Field Lighting Project and request, upon approval from Mr. Weisman, that this item be placed on the April 21, 2009 agenda. Please advise my office of the decision of the approval of the request for funding and placement of this item on the agenda.
