

**Summary:** The Treasure Coast Regional Planning Council (TCRPC) manages and maintains the on-going Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS) which describes the economic conditions of the region and identifies programs and projects that will be undertaken to improve the area's economy. The CEDS Plan is a requirement of the U.S. Department of Commerce Economic Development Administration. The CEDS Committee consists of five (5) appointees from each of the participating counties; Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie and Indian River. Every year the TCRPC will require the appointing authority to review its existing members and either appoint or reappoint members to the CEDS Committee.

**Background and Policy Issues:** On April 2, 2009, the Overall Economic Development Program (OEDP) Committee recommended appointment of the above five representatives to the CEDS Committee. On July 11, 2000, the Board of County Commissioners approved the Resolution R2000-0992 providing for the creation of the Overall Economic Development Program (OEDP) Committee. The OEDP Committee is made up of local government officials, together with representatives of business, industry, finance, agriculture, the professions, organized labor, education, public health agencies, racial/ethnic minorities, and the unemployed and underemployed.
