# I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

# Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

A) Amendment No. 3 to the contract with the Center for Family Services of Palm Beach County (R2007-1928) increasing funding for the Traveler's Aid Program by \$40,000 for a new not-to-exceed total amount of \$54,475, for a new contract total not-to-exceed \$843,377; and revising the definition of unit cost; and

**B)** budget transfer of \$40,000 in the General Fund from Community Services - Human Services Division to Financially Assisted Agencies - Center for Family Services Contract for the period October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2009.

**Summary:** The Department of Community Services through the Financially Assisted Agencies program has been requested to provide \$40,000 in additional funds to the Center for Family Services, specifically in the Traveler's Aid program. This program is currently funded at \$14,475 and will be raised to \$54,475. The Budget Transfer will allocate the additional resources to facilitate services within this program. Additionally, the unit cost definition of the current contract needs to be revised to correctly reflect the entire cost of the program. Funding under this amendment will be used for non-refundable bus tickets to transport homeless individuals to locations where permenant housing has been arranged, case management services, and administrative expenses. This agency is working closely with the County's Homeless Outreach Teams (HOT) under the direction of Human Services to make sure all individuals who qualify will receive this emergency assistance. <u>Countywide (TKF)</u>

**Background and Justification:** In providing for human services needs, Palm Beach County augments its own services mix by providing financial assistance to community-based organizations. This program was established in the early 1980's to overcome the adverse impact of reduced federal funding. More recent federal and state funding reductions emphasize the need for continuing county financial assistance to these organizations. Funded organizations are monitored by the Community Services Department to maintain strict fiscal integrity. Contracts include the following safeguards to protect the County: insurance coverage is mandatory, funds are paid out on a reimbursement basis only, at a rate not to exceed 1/12 of the contracted total per month, and funds cannot be used to initiate or to pursue litigation against the County.

# AMENDMENT TO FINANCIALLY ASSISTED AGENCIES CONTRACT FOR PROVISION OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

#### WITNESETH:

**WHEREAS**, the contract was extended and modified by amendment one per (R2008-2115) November 18<sup>th</sup>, 2008 and;

WHEREAS, the need exists to amend the contract to modify Article 3 – Payments and Exhibit B1 "Service/Program To Be Provided FY 2009 Financial Assistance Contract".

**NOW THEREFORE**, the above named parties hereby mutually agree that the contract is hereby amended as follows:

- I. <u>Article 3 Payments</u> is amended to read "The COUNTY shall pay to the AGENCY for services rendered under this contract, an amount not to exceed <u>Five Hundred Sixty-Eight Thousand, Nine Hundred and Ninety Dollars (\$568,990)</u>.
- **II.** Exhibit B1 is hereby amended and replaced with Exhibit B2 attached hereto and made a part hereof.

# **OTHER PROVISIONS**

The above correction is retroactively applicable to all services provided on and after October 1, 2008.

All provisions in the Contract or exhibits to the Contract in conflict with this Second Amendment to the Contract shall be and are hereby changed to conform to this amendment.

All provisions not in conflict with this Amendment are still in effect and are to be performed at the same level as specified in the Contract.
