I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: A Construction Manager Authorization for Task No. M-5 under the Construction Manager (CM) at Risk Contract with The Morgahti Group, Inc. in the amount of \$223,000 for Construction Phase Services for the Conventional Hangar Roof Repairs and Fixed Base Operator (FBO) Heating, Ventilating and Air Conditioning (HVAC) Renovation at North County General Aviation Airport.

Summary: The Department of Airports is requesting Board approval of Task M-5 to The Morganti Group, Inc. under the continuing contract for CM at Risk Services approved May 20, 2008 (R-2008-0850). Tasks M-1 thru M-4 for The Morganti Group, Inc. were approved in the amount of \$4,197,619.73. The services provided in this Construction Manager Authorization constitute the fifth task to be assigned to The Morganti Group, Inc. Task No. M-5 is in the amount of \$223,000 and establishes a construction time of 60 Calendar Days. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) goal for this contract was established at 15%. The SBE participation for this Task is 17.44%. The total SBE contract participation including Task M-5 is 14.87%. **Countywide** (JCM)

Background and Justification: The work in this task includes roof repairs to the Conventional Metal Hangar (Building 11610). It also includes selective demolition of interior doors, walls and ceilings to accommodate replacing the HVAC systems currently located on the second floor of the FBO Terminal with a new system on the first floor. The Chilled Water System and the Air Handling Units being replaced are original to the FBO Building, which was constructed in 1993. The chilling tower and units were beginning to breakdown continuously and are extremely energy inefficient in comparison to today's standards. The new units meet the most current Florida Building Codes requirements for air flow and energy efficiency.

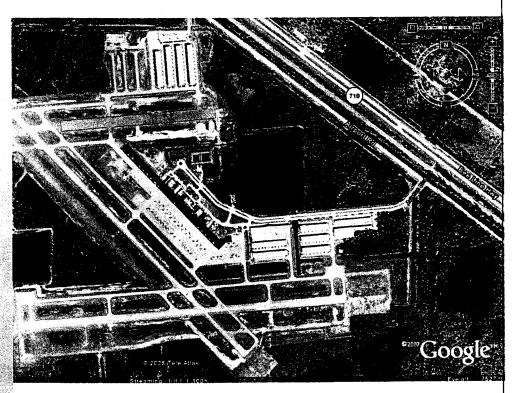

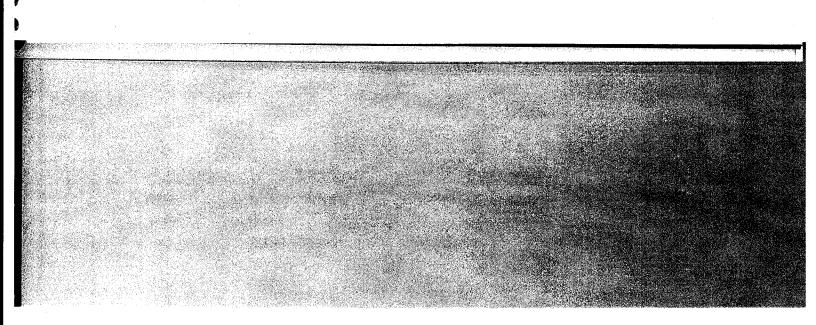

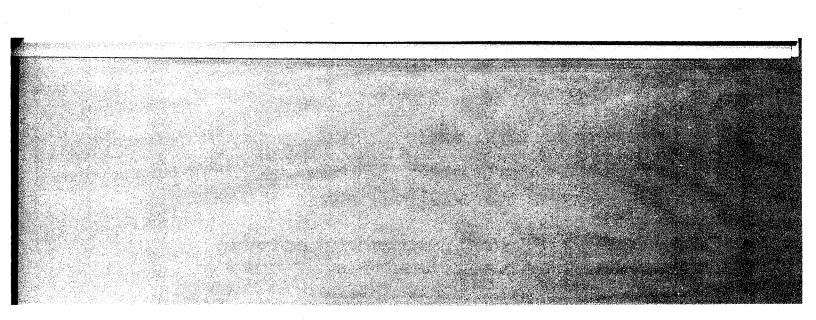

Assumptions and Clarifications

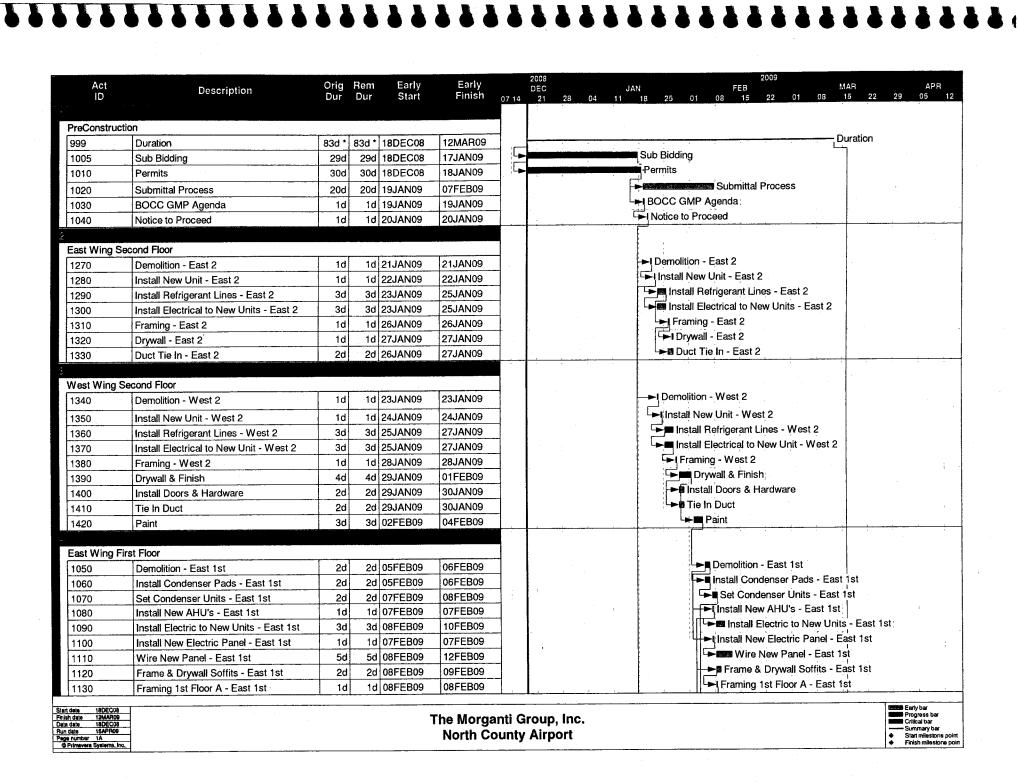
- 1. The Guaranteed Maximum Price does not include any permit fees, deposits, inspection fees, etc.... It is our understanding that any and all required permits will be applied for and paid for by the Owner or by other parties under separate contract.
- 2. This Guaranteed Maximum Price does not include any costs associated with inspections or specialty inspectors of any kind. The Owner will provide all required inspections and certified inspectors required in association with permits provided by SFWMD, DEP, DERM, DERC, NPDES and all other governing agencies that may be applicable to this project.
- The Guaranteed Maximum Price does not include any utility fees including but not limited to tap fees or impact fees, or utility services such as underground/overhead power or gas installation, removal or relocation. The Owner shall pay for all meters, services, transformers and inspections.
- 4. The Guaranteed Maximum Price excludes any cost associated with the removal of any unsuitable materials, asbestos and water damaged building materials.
- 5. On-site utilities shall be available to and utilized by the Construction Manager. Any costs associated with the consumption of these utilities for construction shall be paid for directly by the Owner. The Construction Manager shall use existing services already on-site.
- 6. The anticipated construction start date and contract completion date will be determined from the date all necessary permits and the Notice to Proceed have been issued. Once all documents are obtained a mutually agreed upon schedule will be determined for the scope of work included in the GMP.
- 7. As of the date of the Guaranteed Maximum Price the Owner has not required the Construction Manager to participate in an Owner Provided Insurance Program, therefore it is not included.
- 8. Builders Risk insurance is not included in the Guaranteed Maximum Price, therefore Owner must provide appropriate property insurance.
- 9. It is the Construction Manager's understanding the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) is not an Authority Having Jurisdiction or providing funding on this project; therefore, requirements of the FAA funding are not included in the Guaranteed Maximum Price or any subcontract agreement.
- 10. The Guaranteed Maximum Price does not include any costs associated with revisions to the contract documents that may be required by permitting agencies.
- 11. Wherever the term "at its expense" appears in the agreement between the Owner and Construction Manager it shall only apply to these items specifically included in the Guaranteed Maximum Price.

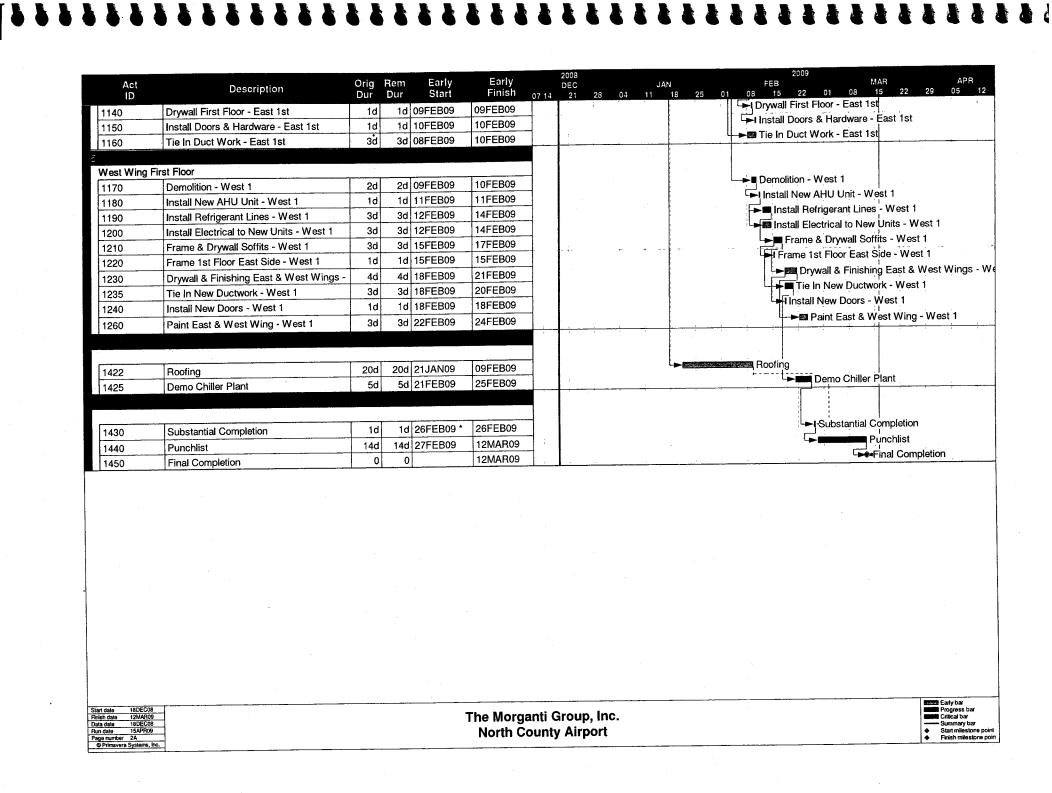

- 12. All material testing shall be paid for and provided by the Owner and will be coordinated with the Construction Manager.
- 13. Owner shall furnish the latest asbestos survey report at least 10 days prior to issuance of the N.T.P. for use in noticing the DEP.
- 14. The Construction Manager's fees, including staffing shall be billed and funded at the same percentage as the complete and stored to date percentage on the monthly Owner's payment requisition.
- 15. Metal roof pricing based on removal and replacement of 240 linear feet per drawing sheet A-1.0
- 16. Existing smoke & duct detectors will be reinstalled in new ducts and air handling units.
- 17. Demolition and removal of the fence enclosure and chiller is included in the GMP. All conduit and pipe that services the chiller shall be cut, capped and abandoned below grade.
- 18. The GMP includes minimizing air conditioning down time while the building is occupied during normal business hours. Any shutdowns during normal business hours will be coordinated with the Department of Airports.
- 19. It is assumed that the facility will be available after normal business hours since the majority of the work required at the FBO building is required to be performed while the build is unoccupied.
