C. Other Department Review:

The Parks and Recreation Department 's management plan approved by the BCC as part of the FCT grant for the Kindt Estate includes the restoration of the original Pineapple Shack structure for adaptive reuse as an educational kiosk. All of the other structures on the Zeke's Marina portion of the site are in such a state of disrepair that the Department cannot undertake the enormous effort and cost for their restoration. Therefore, the Parks and Recreation Department does not support the designation of the large rental cabin and recommends that only the original portion of the Pineapple Shack structure be included under the Historic District designation.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BEACH PALM COUNTY, FLORIDA, EXPANDING THE DUBOIS HISTORIC DISTRICT BY ADDING ONE PROPERTY LOCATED AT THE NORTH END OF DUBOIS ROAD ON THE WEST SIDE SOUTH OF JUPITER INLET IN JUPITER, FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners created the Historic Resources Review Board (HRRB) in Ordinance No. 93-4; and WHEREAS, the HRRB has the power to recommend to the Board of County Commissioners the designation of historic districts and districts located in unincorporated Palm Beach County and County owned properties within municipalities; and

whereas, Objective 4 of the Historic Preservation Element of the 1989 Palm Beach County Comprehensive Plan requires the County to "identify, preserve and protect, on a continuing basis, archaeological and historic resources owned by the County and its agencies;" and

WHEREAS, Article 9 of the Unified Land Development Code requires the County to administer and update an accurate inventory of historic resources in unincorporated Palm Beach County and County owned properties within municipalities; and

WHEREAS, Article 9 of the Unified Land Development Code provides mechanisms to promote historic preservation in the County by the designation of historic sites and districts; and

WHEREAS, Planning, Zoning & Building staff prepared a Designation Application and Report regarding the addition of one property to the DuBois Park Historic District; and

WHEREAS, the HRRB reviewed the Designation Application and Report, held a public hearing on February 19, 2009 and recommended approval of adding one property to the existing DuBois Park Historic District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

- 1. The Board of County Commissioners hereby approves adding the Susan Dubois Kindt Estate Property to the DuBois Park Historic District located at the north end of DuBois Road on the west side south of the Jupiter Inlet in Jupiter, Florida. A map depicting the district and a description of the location of the district are attached to this resolution as Exhibit A.
- 2. This district will be identified as historically significant and listed on the Palm Beach County Register of Historic Places, and the resolution will be recorded in the official records of Palm Beach County.
- 3. The district shall include the archaeological deposits within the soil and one building known as the "Pineapple Shack".
- 4. The provisions of this resolution shall become effective upon adoption by the Board of County Commissioners.


