Summary: The FY 2009 allocation of federal funds for the Miami Urbanized Area, which includes Palm Beach County, is \$105,578,879. The funds are split between Miami Dade, Broward, South Florida Regional Transportation Authority, and Palm Beach County. The grant will fund capital items necessary for the continued operations of the Palm Tran system:  1) Replace buses that have reached their useful life or the acceptable period of use in service; 2) Replace support vehicles that have reached their useful life or the acceptable period of use in service; 3) Paratransit ADA service; 4) Capitalized maintenance items; 5) Transit security projects; 6) Metropolitan planning, surveys to update Transportation Development Plan (TDP) and Title VI program; 7) Shop equipment; 8) Management Information System (M.i.S), equipment; 9) Miscellaneous support equipment; 10) Minor facility renovation projects; 11) Lease for CONNECTION facilities; 12) Preventive maintenance; 13) Employee education and training; 14) Complete transit enhancements to improve fixed route access. The grant requires a 20% local match. Palm Tran has requested approval from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for the use of toll revenue credits as the required local 20% match of the federal dollars for the capital funds. Therefore, the projects budget lists the capital projects at 100% cost for the federal share. No county funds are required. Countywide (DR)

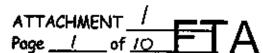
