I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: First amendment to the interlocal agreement (R2005-2156) with the Town of Ocean Ridge (Town) for direct access to the County's 800 MHz Radio System.

Summary: The Agreement which provides the terms and conditions under which the Town can directly access the County's 800 MHz Radio System will expire on October 31, 2009. The agreement provides for two (2) – four (4) year renewals but renewals require approval by both parties. The Town has approved a renewal to extend the term of the agreement until November 1, 2013. The renewal now requires Board approval. The terms of the agreement are standard and have been offered to all municipalities and local branches of State/Federal agencies where connection through an established municipal hub is not technically feasible. The annual fees are consistent with those being charged to the County departments. The Agreement may be terminated by either party, with or without cause, on October 1st of any year, with a minimum of 6 months notice. (ESS) Countywide (JM)

Background and Justification: The Agreement which provides the terms and conditions under which the Town can directly access the County's 800 MHz Radio System, will expire on October 31, 2009.
