FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY AND THE CITY OF WEST PALM BEACH FOR FUNDING OF THE GAINES PARK MULTI-PURPOSE RECREATION CENTER

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT (R-2006-1143 is entered into on _______, by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY", and the City of West Palm Beach, a corporate body politic pursuant to the Constitution of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "MUNICIPALITY".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on June 20, 2006, COUNTY entered into an Agreement with MUNICIPALITY (R-2006-1143) to provide funding in an amount not-to-exceed \$2,000,000 for funding of the Gaines Park Multi-Purpose Recreation Center for the June 20, 2006, through June 19, 2009; and

WHEREAS, MUNICIPALITY has requested a time extension of the Agreement until June 19, 2010, to complete construction of the Gaines Park Multi-Purpose Recreation Center; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY desires to allow for additional project completion time for construction of said project, which will benefit all citizens of Palm Beach County;

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereby agree as follows:

- 1. Section 2.06 of the Agreement shall be amended by <u>deleting</u> "thirty six (36) months from the date of execution of this Agreement by the parties hereto and <u>inserting</u> "until June 19, 2010" in its place.
- 2. Except as provided herein, each and every other term of the Agreement, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect and the Agreement is reaffirmed as modified herein.
