Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: (A) Accept a Department of Justice Office of Justice Programs Edward Byrne Memorial Discretionary grant award in the amount of \$1,650,000 for the period of October 01, 2007 through September 30, 2008; (B) Approve a budget amendment in the amount of \$1,650,000 increasing the Sheriff's Grant fund (Fund 1152).

Summary: On September 26, 2007 the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO) received an award to target violent crime. PBSO will implement a countywide Multi-Agency Violent Crimes Strategy.
