I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Summary:

The current Emergency Services Agreements for Mutual Assistance and Automatic Aid with each of the above agencies will expire on September 30, 2009. The proposed agreements are for a seven (7) year period through September 30, 2016. These agreements provide for fire suppression, emergency medical services, and other emergency services during extraordinary emergency events.

Background and Justification:

The County has agreements for automatic aid and mutual assistance with qualified municipalities for the provision of emergency services throughout Palm Beach County. Mutual Assistance/Automatic Aid agreements provide an improved level of emergency services to all residents of Palm Beach County regardless of jurisdiction.


