I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title:

Staff recommends motion to approve: the Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Professional Firefighters/Paramedics of Palm Beach County, Local 2928, IAFF, Inc., Battalion Chiefs' Supervisory Unit, for the period October 1, 2009 - September 30, 2012.

Summary:

This agreement was ratified by the Union membership. The major elements of this agreement are as follows: across-the-board (ATB) increases in 2nd and 3rd year; annual increase of 7% for health insurance contributions; and changes in pay policy for hours worked above normal 40-hour work schedule. The three-year cumulative fiscal impact amounts to \$166,143 and includes ATB increases as follows:

Background and Justification:

On March 17, 2006 the Public Employee Relations Commission certified a Supervisory Bargaining Unit, which currently includes eight (8) personnel within the Fire-Rescue Department who hold the rank of Battalion Chief. This supervisory unit is part of, and represented by, the Professional Firefighter's and Paramedics of Palm Beach County, Local 2928. Florida Statute 447.309 requires the County to "bargain collectively in the determination of the wages, hours, and terms and conditions of employment for the public employees within that bargaining unit". This agreement represents a three-year extension of the agreement that expires on September 30, 2009. Negotiations and discussions have concluded with the representatives of both parties agreeing with the proposed agreement.
