#### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to adopt: A Resolution to temporarily designate State Road 7 (SR 7) Extension, Orange Grove Boulevard, and Persimmon Boulevard as No Through Truck routes.

**SUMMARY:** The first phase of the SR 7 Extension terminates at Persimmon Boulevard and connects to Orange Grove Boulevard. Orange Grove and Persimmon Boulevards both go through residential neighborhoods that are maintained by Indian Trail Improvement District and were not built to thoroughfare standards. The restriction on SR 7 Extension will be lifted when the SR 7 Extension is built from Persimmon Boulevard to 60<sup>th</sup> Street North.

**Background and Justification:** On August 17, 2009 Palm Beach County constructed and accepted the State Road 7 (SR 7) Extension from Okeechobee Boulevard to Persimmon Boulevard. The second phase of the SR 7 Extension from Persimmon Boulevard to 60<sup>th</sup> Street North is scheduled for construction in 2011 in the Five Year Road Program. The termination of the recently completed phase of construction at Persimmon Boulevard results in some truck traffic going through residential developments along Orange Grove and Persimmon Boulevards. The proposed Resolution will temporarily restrict through truck traffic from using SR 7 Extension, Orange Grove Boulevard between Royal Palm Beach Boulevard and SR 7 Extension, and Persimmon Boulevard between Royal Palm Beach Boulevard and SR 7 Extension. This restriction will be lifted when the SR 7 Extension is built from Persimmon Boulevard to 60<sup>th</sup> Street North, as 60<sup>th</sup> Street North is a thoroughfare road and will be built to the required standards.



# RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, TEMPORARILY DESIGNATING STATE ROAD 7 EXTENSION, ORANGE GROVE BOULEVARD AND PERSIMMON BOUELVARD AS NO THROUGH TRUCK ROUTES

WHEREAS, State Road 7 Extension from Okeechobee Boulevard to Persimmon Boulevard was constructed and accepted by Palm Beach County on August 17, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the first phase of construction terminates at Persimmon Boulevard and connects to Orange Grove Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, Orange Grove Boulevard and Persimmon Boulevard go through residential neighborhoods and were not built to thoroughfare standards; and

WHEREAS, the second phase of State Road 7 Extension from Persimmon Boulevard to 60<sup>th</sup> Street North is scheduled for construction in 2011 in the Five Year Road Program; and

WHEREAS, State Road 7 Extension, Orange Grove Boulevard, and Persimmon Boulevard are on the Thoroughfare Right of Way Identification Map.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida that:

1. The recitations set forth herein above are true, accurate and correct and are incorporated herein.

2. State Road 7 Extension from Okeechobee Boulevard to Persimmon Boulevard, Orange Grove Boulevard from Royal Palm Beach Boulevard to State Road 7 Extension and Persimmon Boulevard from Royal Palm Beach Boulevard to State Road 7 Extension be designated as "No Through Truck" routes.

This restriction on State Road 7 Extension will be lifted when State Road 7
Extension is built from Persimmon Boulevard to 60<sup>th</sup> Street North and is open to traffic.
The restriction on Orange Grove Boulevard and Persimmon Boulevard will be lifted when those roads are built to the standards to handle through traffic.
