I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Work Supplement No. 1666-03B to Palm Beach County Annual Dune & Wetlands Restoration Project No. 2008ERM02 (R2008-1666) with Eastman Aggregate Enterprises, LLC (Eastman), a Palm Beach County company, in the amount of \$293,725.25 and 35 days to provide additional services and time for the completion of the Ibis Isle Restoration Project (R2009-1005).

Summary: Work Supplement No. 1666-03B will authorize Eastman to haul and place additional sand to cap muck sediments at the Ibis Isle Restoration Project (R2009-1005). The Work Supplement is funded by the South Florida Water Management District (R2007-1345) and Manatee Protection Program funds. Eastman's Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation on this Work Supplement is 3.05%. Their SBE contract goal is 16.14%. Eastman's SBE participation to-date is 20.31%. <u>District 7</u> (SF)

Background and Justification: On June 16, 2009, the Board authorized Work Order No. 1666-03 (R2009-1005) to complete the capping and excavation portion associated with the Ibis Isle Restoration Project. Work Supplement No. 1666-03A authorized on July 21, 2009 (R2009-1183) provided additional work items needed to complete the habitat restoration project. Work Supplement No. 1666-03B provides a 35-day extension and additional sand quantities to cap muck sediments. Original fill calculations were based on muck compression estimates exceeded during the initial phase of the work.

Bidder's Sand Source Mileage to PBC Government Center AND 100,000 Tons AND Bidder's Unit Price. The tonnage and mileage quantities used in the following example are not be construed as actual quantities anticipated for the Contract. This is for Evaluation Purposes only.

EXAMPLE: 8 Miles from "Vista Mine" to PBC Gov1 Center X 100,000 Tons X \$0.10/Ton-Mile = \$80,000



Additional ton-miles are calculated starting 1 mile from the source loading site and continuing to the project staging location. Does not include return to source loading site.

The County reserves the right to disqualify any source proposed by a Bidder should the hauling costs from a distant source outweigh the benefits of using the less expensive source.

Evaluation of hauling costs will be based on the Unit Price to haul 100,000 tone multiplied by the mileage from the proposed sand source.
