Motion and title: Staff recommends motion to: A) adopt a Resolution confirming the special assessment process for the Evergreen Drive Water Main Extension; and B) approve a Work Authorization No. 1 to Sheltra & Son Construction Co., Inc., under the Water Utilities Department (WUD) Continuing Construction Contract (R2009-0944) in the amount of \$32,698.25

Summary: Petitions in favor of the installation of a potable water main have been provided by 100% of the westerly three (3) affected property owners on Evergreen Drive located in The Town of Lake Clarke Shores. The project will serve three (3) residential properties currently on private wells. Individual assessments of \$90.35 per front foot are based on 100% of the assessable cost and may be paid over twenty-years (20) with equal annual payments of principal and 6½% interest. The total project cost is \$35,372.03 and includes the costs of surveying, design, drafting, permitting, construction, inspection, administration and construction contingency. The project will be constructed utilizing a Work Authorization under the WUD Continuing Construction Contract with Sheltra & Son Construction Co., Inc. (R2009-0944). The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal established by the SBE Ordinance (R2002-0064) is 15.00% overall. The contract with Sheltra & Son Construction Co., Inc. provides for SBE participation of 15.62%. This Authorization includes 15.96% overall participation. The cumulative SBE participation is 15.96% overall. (WUD Project No. 06-011) District 3 (MJ)

Background and Justification: On August 24, 2007, signed petitions were received from a majority of the property owners on Evergreen Drive. However, two (2) aligned parcels on the privately owned road were opposed and therefore reduced the scope of the project to the first three (3) assessable entry parcels on Evergreen Drive. The original estimated assessable cost of a twenty-year (20) special assessment was \$98.03 per front foot for the construction of water mains and service lines. The original signed petition forms are on file and available for public inspection at the Engineering Office of WUD.

On April 8, 2009, Sheltra & Son Construction Co., Inc. submitted the lowest responsive construction bid for the WUD Continuing Construction Contract (R2000-0944). The construction cost for the Evergreen Drive Water Main Extension is currently \$32,698.25. The total project cost is \$35,372.03, and includes the costs of surveying, design, drafting, permitting, construction, inspection, administration, and construction contingency. The assessable cost of the project is \$35,372.03, which is the total less capital costs of \$6,300 for additional pipeline extension and a \$1.63 adjustment. The assessments are based on 100% of the total assessable cost and 391.5 linear feet of the total assessable front footage resulting in an assessment rate of \$90.35 per front foot.

On Sunday November 1, 2009 a Notice of Special Assessment was published in The Palm Beach Post. All property owners subject to assessment have been sent notification by regular mail pursuant to Ordinance 2001-0010. A final informational meeting was held with the property owners prior to the Public Hearing to explain the proposed improvements and the cost of the project.

RESOLUTION NO. R-2009-

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, CONFIRMING THE SPECIAL ASSESSMENT ROLL FOR THE EVERGREEN DRIVE WATER MAIN IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 8 of Ordinance 2001-0010, the Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing at 9:30 A.M. on the 17th day of November, 2009, at the Commission Chambers of the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida, so as to satisfy the requirements of Ordinance 2001-0010; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that the public notification and public hearing requirements of Ordinance 2001-0010 have been complied with; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners intends to levy special assessment(s) upon certain properties located on Evergreen Drive for the purpose of funding a water main extension; and

WHEREAS, the total assessable costs of the improvement project shall not exceed \$35,372.03; and

WHEREAS, the method of apportioning the assessable costs of the improvement project among the parcels of property located within the boundaries of the improvement project shall be by the frontage method; and

WHEREAS, the maximum dollar amount of each assessment unit shall be \$90.35 per lineal foot based on 391.5 total feet; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that each parcel listed in the Special Assessment Roll, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Attachment "3", will obtain a special benefit, that is at least equal to the amount of special assessment made against each such parcel; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

1. The Special Assessment Roll for the Evergreen Drive Water Main Improvement Project (WUD 06-011) is hereby approved and confirmed, and the special assessments set forth therein shall be collected in accordance with the provisions of the Uniform Assessment Collection Act and Ordinance 2001-0010.

2. The special assessment(s) set forth in the Special Assessment Roll shall constitute a lien(s) against the assessed property equal in rank and dignity with the liens of all state, county, district or municipal taxes and other non-ad valorem assessments. Except as otherwise provided by law, such lien(s) shall be superior in dignity to all other liens, titles and claims, until paid.

3. Any and all special assessments made pursuant to this Resolution, which have not been paid in full within thirty (30) days after completion of the improvement project for which the assessments were made, shall be subject to interest at the rate of six and one half percent (6 $\frac{1}{2}$ %) per year and shall be payable in twenty (20) equal installments of principal and interest.

4. If any special assessment made under this Resolution shall be either in whole or in part vacated or set aside by the judgment of any court, or if the Board of County Commissioners shall be satisfied that any such assessment is so irregular or defective that same cannot be enforced or collected, or if the Board shall have omitted to make such assessment when it might have done so, the Board of County Commissioners shall take all necessary steps to cause a new assessment to be made for any improvement and against any property specially benefited by such improvement, following the provisions of Ordinance 2001-0010. In case the second assessment shall also be invalid, the Board of County Commissioners may obtain and make other assessments until a valid assessment is made.

5. The Clerk of this Board shall cause this Resolution to be recorded in the Official Records of Palm Beach County, Florida, in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court.





AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LAKE CLARKE SHORES, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO AN ORDINANCE OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, REQUESTING THE PALM BEACH COUNTY WATER UTILITIES DEPARTMENT TO INSTALL WATER LINES AND NECESSARY FIRE HYDRANTS IN THE INCORPORATED AREA NORTH OF FOREST HILL BOULEVARD TO ANY AND ALL STREETS THAT HAVE 51% (FIFTY-ONE PERCENT) OF OWNERS AGREEING TO THE INSTALLATION, (EXCLUDING CARANDIS ROAD, CARAMBOLA ROAD AND COMMERCIAL PROPERTIES, WHO MAY NEGOTIATE INDIVIDUALLY); PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Palm Beach County has an ordinance which requires a municipality who wishes for the County to provide a water and/or sewer special assessment project within the municipality's boundaries to adopt an ordinance granting that municipality's consent and authorization to the County to undertake such project and to the County Water Utilities Department to be the service provider; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Lake Clarke ores, Florida, has previously passed Resolution No. <u>720</u> requiring the activities which are the subject of this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Lake Clarke Shores, Florida, wishes to adopt an ordinance regarding the property described herein in order to comply with the County Ordinance referenced above.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LAKE CLARKE SHORES, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1 - The Town Council of the Town of Lake Clarke Shores, Florida, hereby requests the Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department to install water lines and necessary fire hydrants in the incorporated area north of Forest Hill Boulevard to any and all streets that have 51% (fifty-one percent) of owners agreeing to the installation, (excluding Carandis Road, Carambola Road and commercial properties, who may negotiate individually).

SECTION 2 - SEVERABILITY

If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Ordinance is for any reason held by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, inoperative or void, such holding shall not affect the remainder of the Ordinance.

SECTION 3 - INCLUSION IN THE CODE OF LAWS AND ORDINANCES

The provisions of this Ordinance may become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Lake Clarke Shores, Florida. The Sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "chapter," "article," or any other appropriate word.

SECTION 4 - REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT

All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Town of Lake Clarke Shores, Florida which conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5 - EFFECTIVE DATE

The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
