I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to adopt: a Resolution consenting to the renewal of the East Central Regional Wastewater Treatment Facility (ECR) Interlocal Agreement for a term of thirty years.

Summary: On September 9, 1992, the County approved an Interlocal Agreement (R92-1228D) among the County, the City of Lake Worth, the City of Riviera Beach, the Town of Palm Beach, and the City of West Palm Beach (the "Entities") establishing the duties and responsibilities among the Entities for the operation of the ECR Wastewater Treatment Facility. The County has a 36.7% ownership share in the ECR, which treats wastewater flows from the northern portion of the Water Utilities Department's service area. The ECR Interlocal Agreement has an initial term of thirty years, expiring in the year 2022, and has a provision for renewal of the term for an additional thirty years with the consent of all of the Entities. The ECR Board has developed a twenty-year capital plan to replace significant components of the treatment facilities which are nearing the end of their useful lives. However, in order to execute the necessary contractual agreements and obtain financing for the capital plan, the Interlocal agreement must be extended beyond the current expiration date. This Resolution provides the County's consent to extend the term of the Interlocal Agreement for an additional thirty years to the year 2052. Countywide (MJ)

Background and Justification: The ECR allocates to the Entities the costs associated with the operation and maintenance of the treatment plant based on each Entity's proportionate share of total wastewater flow into the plant. In addition to the operating costs, the County makes annual deposits to a Renewal and Replacement Fund and is responsible for its share of major renewal and replacement projects based on the County's percentage of ownership in the ECR Joint Venture. In order to execute contracts and provide funding for the ECR's capital improvement plan, which will likely require 30-year financing, the ECR Interlocal Agreement needs to be extended beyond the current expiration date.

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RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, CONSENTING TO THE RENEWAL OF THE EAST CENTRAL REGIONAL WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR A TERM OF THIRTY YEARS AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 9, 1992, Palm Beach County, by and through its Board of County Commissioners ("County"), approved an Interlocal Agreement ("Interlocal Agreement") (County Resolution R92-1228D) by and among the County, the City of Lake Worth, the City of Riviera Beach, the Town of Falm Beach, and the City of West Palm Beach (the "Entities") establishing the duties and esponsibilities among the Entities for the operation of the East Central Regional Was water Treatment Facility ("ECR"); and

WHEREAS, the ECR Interlocal Agreement as an initial term of thirty years with a renewal term of thirty years upon the consent of the Entities; and

WHEREAS, significant component parts of the ECR treatment facilities will soon reach the end of their useful lives and need to be replaced as part of ECR's capital improvement plan in order to maintain the safe operation of the facilities; and

WHEREAS, the necessary contractual agreements and financing for the capital improvement plan will require that the Interlocal Agreement be extended beyond the existing 2022 term expiration date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

- **Section 1.** The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.
- **Section 2.** The Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County hereby consents to the renewal of the ECR Interlocal Agreement, which term shall commence upon the expiration of the initial thirty year term of the ECR Interlocal Agreement.
- **Section 3.** The provisions of this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption hereof.

Extension of Term of Interlocal Agreement

Dear Chairman Koons;

The Board of the ECR wishes to request Palm Beach County to consent to the renewal of the Term of the ECR Interlocal Agreement.

Pursuant to the Interlocal Agreement dated September 9, 1992, which established the duties and responsibilities among the participating entities (Cities of Lake Worth, Riviera Beach, and West Palm Beach, Town of Palm Beach, and Palm Beach County) in the ECR treatment facilities, the Interlocal Agreement has an initial term of thirty years which can be renewed by the Entities for an additional term of thirty years upon consent of the Entities.

The current term of the Interlocal Agreement does not expire until 2022, however the ECR Board's twenty year capital improvement plan provides for the necessary renewal and replacement of significant component parts of the ECR treatment facilities that have or shortly will reach the end of their useful lives. These projects and the necessary contractual agreements and financing related to these projects are projected to extend beyond the initial 2022 term expiration. Accordingly, to assure that the ECR can execute these required capital improvements and maintain the safe operation of the facilities in accordance with all permit and environmental health, safety and welfare requirements, the term of the Interlocal Agreement would need to be extended beyond the 2022 term expiration date.

We have attached for your convenience a form Term renewal consent Resolution that could be utilized in the event your County determines to grant its consent to the Interlocal Agreement renewal Term.
