Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file: Grant Adjustment Notice Extending the National Institute of Justice (NIJ) "Solving Cold Cases with DNA Program" FY 2007 Grant from June 30, 2009 to June 30, 2010.

Summary: The Board of County Commissioners (BCC) accepted this grant for \$176,235 on November 20, 2007; the original period for this grant was January 1, 2008; through June 30, 2009 (R-2007-2111). This agenda item will extend the grant period from June 30, 2009 to June 30, 2010. The Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO) received this awardfor the Solving Cold Cases with DNA Program. The objective of this grant is to combine the efforts of the PBSO Special Investigations Bureau, Crimes Against Children/Sexual Assault Unit with the Violent Crimes Bureau in conjunction with the experience of the Serology/DNA Section of the Crime Laboratory to solve Cold Cases. These funds, which have been approved by NIJ, will be used to pay overtime, consulting fees and for the purchase of laboratory supplies. There is no match requirement associated with this award.
