I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

- A) A blanket approval for appraisal and acquisition of the lands, rights-of-way, and easements on all Fiscal Year 2010 projects as identified in the Five Year Road Program Annual Update, as adopted on November 17, 2009; and
- B) The employment of all experts, including but not limited to real estate appraisers, engineers, certified public accountants, business damage experts, and other experts, deemed necessary to appraise and acquire the before mentioned lands, rights-of-way, and easements.

SUMMARY: On November 17, 2009, the Board of County Commissioners adopted the Annual Update of the Five Year Road Program for Fiscal Year 2010 through Fiscal Year 2014. Approval of this item will provide for the acquisitions necessary to accomplish the road goals set therein.

Countywide (PK)

Background and Justification: On December 3, 1985, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approved and adopted Ordinance No. 85-40 establishing the Five Year Road Program.

Each year since 1987, the Board has granted blanket approval to appraise and acquire the lands, rights-of-way, and easements for projects on the adopted Five Year Road Program during each fiscal year.

Therefore, the Right-of-Way Acquisition Section is recommending a blanket approval to appraise and acquire lands, rights-of-way, and easements, and to approve the employment of all experts, including but not limited to real estate appraisers, engineers, certified public accountants, business damage experts, and other experts, deemed necessary for projects on said budgeted Five Year Road Program that will be undertaken during the fiscal year of 2010. The approval of this item will speed up the lengthy process of acquiring lands, rights-of-way, and easements.

PALMETTO PARK RD. - 0.5 MI. W. OF MILITARY TR. TO I-95.: Anticipates Florida Department of Transportation (CIGP) funds towards the construction.

WEST ATLANTIC AVE. - W. OF LYONS RD. TO STARKEY RD.: Anticipates Florida Department of Transportation (TRIP) funds and Developer funds towards the construction.
