I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Work Order No. 1666-04 to the Palm Beach County Annual Dune & Wetlands Restoration Project No. 2008ERM02 (R2008-1666) with Eastman Aggregate Enterprises, LLC (Eastman), a Palm Beach County company, in the amount of \$344,621.94 to provide restoration services for the Pondhawk Natural Area Restoration Project.

Summary: The BCC approved the Palm Beach County Annual Dune & Wetlands Restoration Project No. 2008ERM02 (R2008-1666) on September 23, 2008. Work Order No. 1666-04 authorizes Eastman to provide excavation and grading services for the Pondhawk Natural Area Restoration Project. The Work Order is funded by the Natural Areas Project Fund, a non ad valorem source and the Parks Improvement Fund. Eastman's Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation on this Work Order is 11.39%. Their SBE contract goal is 16.14%. Eastman's SBE participation to-date is 18.76%. District 4 (JM)

Background and Justification: This project will create approximately 8.3 acres of wetland restoration area within the boundaries of Pondhawk Natural Area. The wetland restoration area will be constructed to replace a sawgrass marsh that ran through the property prior to the drop of the groundwater table due to drainage of adjacent properties. The project will also provide an area to complete the promenade at the City of Boca Raton's Spanish River Public Library. Excess sand from the project will be used on other County Capital Projects.
