

Dear Mr. Patel:

MPA would like to thank you for the opportunity to present the following proposal to Palm Beach County Capital Improvements Division for the design of Fire Rescue Station No. 72. The new station will be based on Fire Rescue Station No. 31 with modifications to include a three bay drive thru apparatus room and an expanded bunk room from six to eight fire fighters. This will affect the plan layout and elevations. Electrical and mechanical systems will be expanded to accommodate the changes. It is our understanding that the project will be designed to comply with House Bill 7135 which states that all county and municipal buildings shall be constructed to meet the USGBC (LEED) V3.0 2009 version. The effective date of HB7135 was July 1, 2008.

The following is our proposed scope of services:

- I. Schematic Design Phase
 - A. Facilitate kick off meeting with Owner and consultants to establish green building (LEED) expectations.
 - B. Review owner supplied site plan to and make minor adjustment.
 - C. Supply exterior building redesign drawings based on expanded program for site plan approval.
 - D. Coordinate all consultants' site plan submittal requirements for use by Palm Beach County site plan approval consultant.
 - E. Attend the following meetings with The City of Pahokee and Owner's consultant during site plan approval process.

- F. Submit schematic design documents to and meet with Palm Beach County to review program requirements.
- G. Incorporate any revisions from F.

II. Design Development Phase

- A. Based on approved schematic design submittal, prepare design development drawings for architectural, civil engineering, landscape and irrigation as applicable structural engineering, mechanical, electrical, plumbing engineering and specifications.
- B. Provide owner with USGBC checklist and a brief statement of applied credits.
- C. Submit design development documents to and meet with Palm Beach County to review.
- D. Incorporate any revisions from C.

III. Construction Document Phase

- A. Based on approved design development documents, prepare 50% construction documents including architectural, civil, landscape and irrigation, structural engineering, mechanical, electrical, plumbing engineering and specifications.
- B. Submit 50% construction documents to and meet with Palm Beach County to review.
- C. Based on approved 50% construction documents, prepare 95% construction documents including architectural, civil, landscape and irrigation, structural engineering, mechanical, electrical, plumbing engineering and specifications.
- D. Prepare preliminary estimate of probable construction cost based on 50% and 95% construction documents.

- E. Submit 95% construction documents to and meet with Palm Beach County to review and submit for permitting.
- F. Based on 95% construction document review and permit comments, complete 100% construction documents for bidding.
- G. File for and obtain permits to construct the project...

IV. Bidding Phase

- A. Submit one original copy of 100% construction documents (plans and specifications) to Palm Beach County for reproduction for bidding phase.
- B. Prepare addenda as required during the bidding phase that address contractor RFIs.
- C. Incorporate all final comments and RFI's into final contract set of documents.

V. Construction Administration Phase

- A. Conduct two job site meetings per month with Owner and Contractor. One meeting will focus on review of Contractor's pay application and one meeting will focus on Contractor's progress. Owner's representative will conduct all site inspections for compliance with USGBC LEED checklist.
- B. Review shop drawing submittals.
- C. Respond to RFIs from General Contractor.
- D. Review change order request and provide justification to Owner.
- E. Prepare punch list at substantial completion.
- F. Prepare substantial and final completion documents.
