I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: (A) Receive and File: Grant Adjustment Notice amending the United States Department of Justice Office of Justice Programs Grant to extend the ending grant period from September 30, 2009 thru January 31, 2010; and **(B) Approve** a Budget Amendment of \$1,816 in the Sheriff's Grant Fund.

Summary: The Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) accepted this grant for \$19,074 on January 13, 2009; the original period for this grant was October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2009 (R-2009-0138). This agenda item will extend the grant period from September 30, 2009 through January 31, 2010. The City of West Palm Beach, received an award from the United States Department of Justice Office of Justice Programs for the Gramercy Village Weed and Seed. On November 19, 2008 the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO) and the City of West Palm Beach entered into an agreement to continue the Gramercy Village Community Area Multi-Agency Law Enforcement Unit (MALEU). The objective of the MALEU is to prevent, control, and reduce violent crime, drug abuse, and gang activity in the Gramercy Village Community Area. Under this agreement, the PBSO will receive reimbursable funds for overtime costs associated with the program. The PBSO has been given an extension to allow the grant funds to be fully expended. The award was not fully expended in FY 2009. The balance of the award being carried forward into FY 2010 is \$1,816. There is no match requirement associated with this award. No additional positions are needed and no additional County funds are required. <u>District 7 (DW)</u>

Background and Justification: Weed and Seed, a community-based strategy sponsored by the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), is an innovative, comprehensive multi-agency approach to law enforcement, crime prevention, and community revitalization. Weed and Seed is a comprehensive, multi-disciplinary approach to combating violent crime, drug use, and gang activity in high crime neighborhoods. The goal is to "weed out" violence and drug activity in high crime neighborhoods and then to "seed" the sites with a wide range of crime and drug prevention programs, human service resources, and neighborhood restoration activities to prevent crime from reoccurring. The strategy emphasizes the importance of a coordinated approach, bringing together Federal, State and local government, the community, and the private sector to form a partnership to create a safe, drug-free environment. The Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) number is 16.595.
