#### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends a motion to adopt: A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A RESPONDING RESOLUTION, AUTHORIZING PALM BEACH COUNTY TO COMMENCE THE NEGOTIATION PROCESS FOR AN INTERLOCAL SERVICE BOUNDARY AGREEMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY AND THE CITY OF BOYNTON BEACH, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 171, PART II, FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Summary: On December 15, 2009, the City of Boynton Beach adopted an Initiating Resolution No. R09-188 pursuant to Chapter 171, Part II, F.S., as a first step in the process of completing an Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement (ISBA) for an area designated outside of the boundaries of the City. The ISBA is a process established in the Florida Statutes that is intended to encourage local government coordination in planning, service delivery, and boundary adjustments due to annexation. The area subject to the negotiations is depicted in Exhibit A of the resolution. This resolution also identifies issues that may be negotiated during the process, including identifying service providers and possible planned improvements. County staff has identified additional issues to be negotiated including the boundaries themselves and the primary goals of the ISBA to address the annexation of enclaves and pockets, including the San Castle neighborhood. This responding resolution does not annex any property at this time, but is the vehicle through which the negotiation process can begin. Planning Staff will work closely with key County agencies and City staff during the months following the adoption of the responding resolution to work to develop an Interlocal Agreement, which may be subsequently presented to the Board at a later date. Background and Policy Issues: One of the City's main goals is to utilize the water service agreements, which have a voluntary annexation clause, for a few neighborhoods adjacent to the City's current municipal boundary. The City of Boynton has notified the Coalition of Boynton West Residential Associations (COBWRA) of the proposed ISBA, given that the area identified for negotiations for the proposed ISBA is part of the COBWRA neighborhood plan. The Intergovernmental Coordination Element Objective 1.4 states that Palm Beach County shall adopt policies and implement strategies which support municipal efforts to secure boundary changes that maintain cost-effective service delivery, assist in the elimination of enclaves, pockets and finger-like areas, and ensure consistency between municipal and County land use. The Statutes establish the Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement process as a flexible, joint planning option for Counties and municipalities to cooperatively adjust municipal boundaries while planning for service delivery and land use changes. Pursuant to State Statutes, this item is being presented to the Board within 60 days of receipt of the City's adoption of their initiating resolution. This proposed resolution is consistent with the Intergovernmental Coordination Element of the Comprehensive Plan.

#### RESOLUTION NO. R-2010-

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A RESPONDING RESOLUTION, AUTHORIZING PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA TO COMMENCE THE NEGOTIATION PROCESS FOR AN INTERLOCAL SERVICE BOUNDARY AGREEMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY AND THE CITY OF BOYNTON BEACH, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 171, PART II, FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Coordination Element of the 1989 Comprehensive Plan states that Palm Beach County shall adopt policies and implement strategies which support municipal efforts to secure boundary changes that maintain cost-effective service delivery, assist with the elimination of enclaves, pockets and finger-like areas, and ensure consistency between municipal and County land use; and

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Coordination Element Policy of the 1989 Comprehensive Plan requires Palm Beach County to support municipal efforts to secure boundary changes; and

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Coordination Element Policy of the 1989 Comprehensive Plan requires the County to work with municipalities to determine areas to be considered for annexation; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 171, Part II, Florida Statutes (2009), as amended, establishes the Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement process as a flexible, joint planning option for Counties and municipalities to cooperatively adjust municipal boundaries while planning for service delivery and land use changes; and

WHEREAS, on December 15, 2009, the City of Boynton Beach adopted an Initiating Resolution pursuant to Chapter 171, Part II, F.S., to commence the negotiation process for an interlocal service boundary agreement for the area to be negotiated (referred to herein as the "Area") described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the City of Boynton Beach complied with Chapter 171.203(1)(b), F.S., by sending a notification of the initiating resolution by United States certified mail to each municipality within Palm Beach County; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 171, Part II, Florida Statutes (2009), states that the Responding Resolution be presented to the Board of County Commissioners within sixty (60) days of receipt of the City's adoption of their Initiating Resolution. The County received the certified Initiating Resolution on January 21, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Palm Beach County to negotiate an Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement with the City of Boynton Beach for the Area to be negotiated, described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners hereby agrees to negotiate in good faith with the City of Boynton Beach, in accordance with Chapter 171.203, Florida Statutes, to prepare an Interlocal Agreement to provide for a streamlined annexation and land use amendment process and schedule for properties within the "Area" to be negotiated and to designate the service provider(s) for the services

identified in Section 2 herein.

<u>Section 2.</u> Palm Beach County agrees that negotiations regarding an Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement will address, at a minimum, issues concerning service delivery, fiscal responsibilities, and boundary adjustment as they concern the City's and the County's responsibilities for the funding and delivery of the following services:

- 1. Public safety
- 2. Fire, emergency rescue, and medical
- 3. Water and wastewater
- 4. Road ownership, construction, and maintenance
- 5. Conservation, parks, and recreation
- 6. Stormwater management and drainage

Section 3. Negotiations regarding an Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement will address land use designations within the area to be negotiated, outlined in Exhibit "A".


<u>Section 4.</u> The Town of Lantana, the Village of Hypoluxo, the Town of Ocean Ridge, the Town of Briny Breezes, Village of Golf and the City of Delray Beach are hereby invited to participate in the Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement negotiations. However, per Chapter 171.203(2), Florida Statutes, they must, within sixty (60) days of the effective date of this resolution, adopt a responding resolution in order to participate.

Section 5. The provisions of this resolution shall become effective upon adoption by the Board of County Commissioners. The foregoing Resolution was offered by Commissioner \_\_who moved its adoption. #### **RESOLUTION NO. 09-188**

A RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF BOYNTON BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOYNTON BEACH TO INITIATE THE NEGOTIATION PROCESS FOR AN INTERLOCAL SERVICE BOUNDARY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BOYNTON BEACH AND PALM BEACH COUNTY, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 171, PART II, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL ACT AS THE REQUIRED INITIATING RESOLUTION UNDER CHAPTER 171.203, FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of Boynton Beach deems it to be in the best nterest of the City to negotiate an Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement with Palm Beach County for the area described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by this reference made a part nereof; and

WHEREAS, the City of Boynton Beach desires to annex properties within the Palm Beach County Urban Services Area boundary; and

WHEREAS, the area described in Exhibit "A" is within the future annexation area of the City of Boynton Beach as set forth in the Intergovernmental Coordination Element of the City's Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 171, Part II, Florida Statutes, establishes a more flexible process of adjusting municipal boundaries through intergovernmental coordination in planning and service delivery; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 171.203(1)(a), Florida Statutes, provides that other municipalities may be invited to also participate in the Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement negotiations and the City of Boynton Beach is aware that the Town of Lantana, the Village of Hypoluxo and the City of Delray Beach may desire to be included in the negotiations.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF BOYNTON BEACH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The above referenced whereas clauses are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. The City of Boynton Beach, Florida hereby agrees to negotiate in good faith with Palm Beach County, in accordance with Chapter 171.203, Florida Statutes, regarding a streamlined annexation and land use amendment process for property currently in the unincorporated area of the County as outlined in Exhibit "A", a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and further agrees to address during the negotiations the issues outlined in Section 2 and 3 herein;

Section 3. The City of Boynton Beach agrees that negotiations regarding an interlocal Service Boundary Agreement will address, at a minimum, issues concerning service delivery, fiscal responsibilities, and boundary adjustment as they concern the City's and the County's responsibilities for the funding and delivery of the following services:

1. Public safety.

- 2. Fire, emergency rescue, and medical.
- 3. Water and wastewater.
- 4. Road ownership, construction, and maintenance.
- 5. Conservation, parks, and recreation.
- 6. Stormwater management and drainage.

Section 4. Negotiations regarding an Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement will also address land use designations within the area outlined in Exhibit "A" and the City's vision for this area.

Section 5. The Town of Lantana, the Village of Hypoluxo, the Town of Ocean Ridge, the Town of Briny Breezes, Village of Golf and the City of Delray Beach are hereby invited to participate in the Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement negotiations. However, per Chapter 171.203(2), Florida Statutes, they must, within sixty (60) days of the effective date of this resolution, adopt a responding resolution in order to participate.

Section 6. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
