RESOLUTION THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF A CERTAIN AMBULANCE/RESCUE VEHICLE (ASSET NO. 10180724), AND TRANSFER OF ITS TITLE, TO THE VILLAGE OF PALM SPRINGS, CONTINGENT UPON RECEIPT OF TEN CONSIDERATION AND AN EXECUTED ACCEPTANCE FORM, PURSUANT TO SECTION 125.38, FLORIDA STATUTES: PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village of Palm Springs (hereinafter the "Village") is an incorporated municipality within Palm Beach County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, as of October 1, 2009, the County provides fire-rescue services to the Village pursuant to the Village's participation in the County's Fire/Rescue Municipal Service Taxing Unit (hereinafter the "Fire/Rescue MSTU") and an Interlocal Agreement for Fire Protection and Emergency Medical Services between the County and the Village (R2009-1552), which Agreement provided for the transfer of all Village fire-rescue apparatus and related equipment from the Village to the County; and

WHEREAS, a certain ambulance/rescue vehicle transferred to the County (Make: Ford F450 Ambulance (AMR Body), Identification number: 1FDWF36F41EB90181, Palm Beach County Asset No. 10180724) (hereinafter the "Vehicle") does not meet County Fire/Rescue standards, and has minimal useful value to the Fire/Rescue MSTU; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires and has requested that the County convey the Vehicle back to the Village to be used by the Village's Utilities Department for response to incidents within their community; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County (hereinafter the "Board") is satisfied that the Vehicle is not needed for County purposes, has minimal useful value to the Fire/Rescue MSTU, and is required by the Village for the above stated intended use, which will enhance public services and benefit the public interest and welfare within the Fire/Rescue MSTU.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference. Pursuant to Section 125.38, Florida Statutes, the Board hereby authorizes Section 2. the conveyance of the Vehicle (Asset No. 10180724), and transfer of its title, to the Village, contingent upon receipt of \$10.00 consideration from the Village and receipt of the attached Acceptance of Fire-Rescue Vehicle(s) and/or Equipment form duly executed by the Village upon its acceptance of the Vehicle. **Section 3.** The provisions of this Resolution shall be effective immediately. Village understands and agrees that the County is not the manufacturer or merchant of the transferred vehicle(s) and/or equipment as identified above, nor the agent of said manufacturer or merchant, and that no warranties, whether express or implied, are given by County.

THE VEHICLE(S) AND/OR EQUIPMENT TRANSFERRED TO VILLAGE BY THE COUNTY, AND ACCEPTED BY VILLAGE HEREUNDER, ARE TRANSFERRED, CONVEYED AND ACCEPTED "AS IS". NO WARRANTIES, WHETHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, ARE GIVEN. ALL IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND/OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE ARE EXPRESSLY EXCLUDED.

Village acknowledges and agrees that it has fully inspected the vehicles and/or equipment identified above and is accepting said vehicle(s) and/or equipment in complete reliance upon Village's inspection of said vehicles and/or equipment and upon Village's own knowledge and expertise in evaluating the condition of the said vehicles and/or equipment and Village's intended use of said vehicles and/or equipment. Village acknowledges and agrees that in accepting said vehicles and/or equipment, Village has not, and shall not, rely upon any statement, advice, information or representation made by the County or any of its employees, officers or agents. No oral or written statement, advice, information or representation from County or any of its employees, officers or agents, whether given before or after delivery of the vehicle(s) and/or equipment, shall create a warranty, and Village acknowledges and agrees that it has not, and shall not, rely on any such advice, information or representation.

Village understands and agrees that the County is not a seller engaged in the business of selling vehicles and/or equipment such as those identified above. Village shall be solely responsible for inspecting the vehicle(s) and/or equipment identified above for any defects, either latent or patent, and for refurbishing and repairing said vehicle(s) and/or equipment as necessary prior to their use and operation, and that the County shall have no obligation or liability for such. Village

acknowledges that the County has warned Village, and Village specifically understands, that the vehicle(s) and/or equipment identified above may not be suitable or safe for Village's intended use and operation until inspected, repaired and refurbished by Village, and Village agrees to do so prior to allowing the use and/or operation of said vehicle(s) and/or equipment. Village shall be solely responsible for continuing maintenance of the transferred vehicle(s) and/or equipment, and the County shall have no obligation or liability for such.

Hold Harmless and Indemnification. To the extent permitted by law, Village shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the County, including its employees, officers, and agents, against any actions, claims or damages arising out of Village's use, possession, operation, maintenance or ownership of any vehicle(s) and/or equipment transferred to, and accepted by, Village. The foregoing shall not constitute a waiver of sovereign immunity beyond the limits set forth in Section 768.28, Florida Statutes.
