I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to adopt: an ordinance of the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida, amending Ordinance No. 07-003, as amended by Ordinance No. 09-004 and Ordinance No. 09-041, providing for a schedule of rates for interruptible reclaimed water service; providing for a priority capacity reservation system; providing for repeal of laws in conflict; providing for severability; providing for captions; and providing for an effective date.

Summary: This Ordinance Amendment establishes rates for reclaimed water produced at the East Central Regional Wastewater Treatment Facilities (ECR) that can be provided to potential customers on an interruptible basis. In accordance with the Reclaimed Water Agreements with Florida Power and Light (FPL) (R2008-0906) and the ECR Board (R2008-0907), the County has approximately 27 million gallons per day (MGD) of reclaimed water available and is contractually obligated to provide FPL's West County Energy Center (WCEC) with an average daily flow (ADF) of 22 MGD, varying from 4 MGD minimum daily flow to 27 MGD peak daily flow. Since the WCEC's requirements vary throughout the year, a significant amount of reclaimed water can be made available to potential customers on an interruptible basis during those times when the WCEC's needs have been met. The recommended rates include a reservation fee of \$0.13 per thousand gallons per day ADF (\$47.45 per 1,000 gallons of reserved capacity) payable upon execution of an agreement and annually thereafter and a reclaimed water interruptible commodity fee of \$0.51 per thousand gallons payable monthly based on usage. The commodity fee will be indexed annually based on three-fourths of the change in the CPI, Water and Sewer Maintenance in accordance with the existing Ordinance. The reservation fee will not be indexed since it represents the recovery of fixed interest costs on the reclaimed water bonds. In accordance with the Reclaimed Water Agreement with FPL, FPL will receive a portion of the revenue from interruptible customers since FPL is paying the full cost of constructing and operating the facilities and pipelines and is responsible for the debt service on the project. The County's share of the revenue from prospective interruptible customers is approximately \$0.01 of the capacity reservation fee and \$0.19 of the commodity fee per thousand gallons in accordance with the agreement. Interruptible reclaimed water service will be provided on a priority reserved capacity basis. The County will enter into agreements with potential customers and make deliveries of water on a prioritized basis—fully satisfying the requested water delivery needs of the customer with the earliest agreement date before making delivery to the customer with the second earliest agreement date, and so forth. Each customer is limited to the maximum amount of reclaimed water. Reservation fee payments must be current in order for the County to make deliveries to customers. Countywide (MJ)

Background and Justification: In order to reduce the cost of deep well disposal, it is beneficial to the County to sell as much available reclaimed water from the ECR as possible. Although the WCEC has priority to accept the amount of reclaimed water it needs for cooling, a significant amount of reclaimed water can be made available on an interruptible basis to other potential customers. The County will share in the revenue from such sales, and potential customers near the reclaimed pipeline will benefit from having the reclaimed water available.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 07-003, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 09-004 AND ORDINANCE NO. 09-041, PROVIDING FOR A SCHEDULE OF RATES FOR INTERRUPTIBLE RECLAIMED WATER SERVICE; PROVIDING FOR A PRIORITY CAPACITY RESERVATION SYSTEM; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CAPTIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, through its Water Utilities Department, provides potable water, wastewater, and reclaimed water services to approximately 507,000 citizens of Palm Beach County; and

WHEREAS, the Water Utilities Department (Department) operates as an enterprise fund of the County and therefore must recover the costs of operation through rates, fees, and charges for services rendered; and

WHEREAS, Section 153.11, Florida Statutes, requires that such rates, fees and charges shall be so fixed and revised as to provide funds, with other funds available for such purposes, sufficient at all times to pay the cost of maintaining, repairing and operating the system or systems including the reserves for such purposes and for replacements and depreciation and necessary extensions, to pay the principal of and the interest on the water revenue bonds and/or sewer revenue bonds as the same shall become due and the reserves there for, and to provide a margin of safety for making such payments; and

WHEREAS, such rates, fees and charges shall be just and equitable and may be based or computed upon the quantity of water consumed and/or upon the number and size of sewer connections or upon the number and kind of plumbing fixtures in use in the premises connected with the sewer system or upon the number or average number of persons residing or working in or otherwise connected with such premises or upon any other factor affecting the use of the facilities furnished or upon any combination of the foregoing factors; and

WHEREAS, Water Utilities revenue bond covenants require the County to establish and maintain rates and collect such fees, rentals or other charges for services and facilities and to revise same from time to time whenever necessary, in order to meet debt service and debt service reserve requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Water Utilities Department's rate consultants have completed a review of the rates that should be charged for interruptible reclaimed water service to potential customers near the pipeline transporting reclaimed water from the East Central Regional Wastewater Treatment Facilities (ECR) to the West County Energy Center (WCEC); and

WHEREAS, under the terms of the interlocal agreement between the County, the ECR, and WPB related to the provision of reclaimed water to the WCEC (R2008-0907), the ECR Board, and its member entities, agreed to allocate certain secondary treated effluent of sufficient quality to be available to the County to provide reclaimed water to the WCEC in accordance with the agreement between the County and Florida Power and Light (FPL) (Resolution No. R2008-0906) and other customers; and

WHEREAS, actual WCEC requirements for reclaimed water are expected to vary significantly on an annual cycle with higher cooling water demands occurring at times of higher regional rainfall and consequent lower irrigation needs; and

WHEREAS, the County can make available up to 8 MGD of reclaimed water capacity to other customers after the WCEC's reclaimed water capacity requirements as delineated in the FPL Reclaimed Water Agreement are fully satisfied; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish rates and charges for interruptible reclaimed water service and to include such rates in the Department's Uniform Policies and Procedures (UPAP) Manual.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 07-003, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 09-004 AND ORDINANCE 09-041.

Section 1 of Ordinance No. 07-003 is hereby amended as follows: The revised schedule of rates, fees, and charges shown at Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby adopted. The rates, fees, and charges set forth in Exhibit "A" shall become effective on the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. PRIORITY CAPACITY RESERVATION SYSTEM.

Interruptible reclaimed water service shall be provided on a priority reserved capacity basis. The County shall enter into agreements with reclaimed water customers for the delivery of specified amounts of reclaimed water on an interruptible, as-available basis. The County shall make deliveries of water on a prioritized basis—fully satisfying the requested water delivery needs of the customer with the earliest agreement date before making delivery to the next. The County reserves the right to limit the total amount of interruptible, reclaimed water represented by the agreements or to set constraints on diurnal or seasonal constraints on deliveries. Each customer shall be limited to the maximum amount of reserved reclaimed water specified in the customer's interruptible reclaimed water agreement.

SECTION 3. REPEAL OF LAWS IN CONFLICT.

All local laws and ordinances in conflict with any provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.

If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Ordinance is for any reason held by the Court to be unconstitutional, inoperative, or void, such holding shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5 CAPTIONS.

The captions, section headings, and section designations used in this Ordinance are for convenience only and shall have no effect on the interpretation of the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.

The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective upon filing with the Department of State.

6.2 PLAN REVIEW AND INSPECTION FEES

6.2.1 CONSTRUCTION PLAN REVIEW FEE

Payable at the time of plan submission for potable water, reclaimed water and/or wastewater projects

- Residential \$50.00 per dwelling unit for individual or combined service with a \$750.00 minimum.
- Non-Residential \$50.00 per ERC based on meter size for individual or combined service with a \$750.00 minimum.

6.2.2 CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION FEE

Four percent (4%) of total estimated cost as provided by the developer and approved by the Department for all potable water, reclaimed water and/or wastewater construction improvements with a \$500.00 minimum for Residential and Non-Residential projects. The inspection fees for "Department required" oversized facilities shall be based on construction cost estimates for the "Development required" facilities, subject to minimum sizes as specified in Chapter 3 of the Uniform Policies and Procedures Manual. This fee is due prior to the pre-construction conference. If the actual construction cost values stated on the "Attachment to the Bill of Sale" exceed the Engineer's cost estimate by \$25,000 or more, then additional construction inspection fees equal to four percent (4%) of the difference between the Engineer's cost estimate and the actual construction values must be paid to the Department prior to any water meters being released.

6.3 SERVICE INITIATION FEES

Service Initiation Fees shall include all applicable Guaranteed Revenue Fees, Connection Fees, Service Installation Fees, Fireline Connection Fees and Franchise Fees.

6.3.1 GUARANTEED REVENUE FEES:

An amount equal to sixty (60) months of Guaranteed Revenue Fees is due at the time of service initiation.

6.3.3 SERVICE INSTALLATION FEES

If a Property Owner requests to have a water meter installed, and the site is not ready for meter installation, the work area will be tagged and the reason for not installing the meter shall be indicated. The Department will return a second time for installation at no charge. If the site still is not ready, a trip fee must be paid prior to each subsequent visit to the site.

6.5 PRETREATMENT FEES

6.5.1 INDUSTRIAL WASTEWATER DISCHARGE PERMIT FEE

Significant Industrial Users (SIU) will be billed \$300 on an annual basis for an Industrial

potable water system.

** For billing purposes, the connection fee is based on the size of the backflow prevention assembly.

Wastewater Discharge Permit Fee. Other Industrial Users requiring an Industrial Wastewater Discharge Permit will be billed \$300 on an annual basis.

6.5.2 OGI FEE

All facilities having an OGI will be billed \$300 per account on an annual basis.

6.5.3 MONTHLY INDUSTRIAL WASTE SURCHARGE (IWS)

An IWS shall be billed to and paid by IUs exceeding discharge standards as calculated below. The IWS shall not exceed the total charge for water and wastewater base facility fees and commodity fees for the month in which the IWS is charged.
