On October 6, 2009, the BOCC received and filed an agenda item extending the grant period from March 31, 2009 through December 31, 2009 (R-2009-1713). This agenda item will extend the grant period from December 31, 2009 to June 30, 2010. The State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management awarded these funds to the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO) for the Regional Virtual Fusion Center under the State Homeland Security Grant Program. This project is an extension of the PBSO's integration of its local applications supporting countywide, regional and statewide data sharing. PBSO will streamline its operational and intelligence focused systems in web-based architectures to be shared and extended as appropriate to users within the Sheriff's office, to municipal agencies, and within the Florida Department of Law Enforcement Region. MODIFICATION #5 TO GRANT AGREEMENT

This Modification is made and entered into by and between the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management, ("the Division"), and Palm Beach County Sheriff's ("the Recipient) to restate and modify the Division's Contract Number 07DS-5N-10-60-23-431, dated March 19, 2007 ("the Agreement").

WHEREAS, the Division and the Recipient have entered into the Agreement, pursuant to which the Division has provided a sub grant of \$32,445 to Recipient; and

WHEREAS, The Agreement expired on December 31, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Division and the Recipient desire to reinstate and modify the Agreement by extending it.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. The Agreement is hereby reinstated as though it had not expired.
2. Paragraph 3, Period of Agreement, is hereby amended to have an expiration date for the Agreement of June 30, 2010. Final requests for reimbursement should be submitted no later than thirty (30) days after the termination date of the contract. Any requests received after July 30, 2010 may, in the discretion of the Division, not be reimbursed from this Agreement.
3. All provisions not in conflict with this Modification remain in full force and effect, and are to be performed at the level specified in the Agreement.
4. All provisions of the Agreement being modified and any attachments thereto in conflict with this Modification shall be and are hereby changed to conform with this Modification, effective as of the date of the last execution of this Modification by both parties.
