**A RESOLUTION OF THE PALM BEACH COUNTY
HOMELESS ADVISORY BOARD
RECOMMENDING THAT THE BOARD OF
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OPPOSE AN
AMENDMENT TO THE FLORIDA CONSTITUTION
THAT WOULD REQUIRE VOTERS TO DECIDE
ALL CHANGES TO A CITY OR COUNTY'S
COMPREHENSIVE PLAN.**

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has experienced tremendous growth; and

WHEREAS, the challenges presented by growth require that communities embrace smart growth policies aimed at protecting our State's quality of life, engendering greater economic prosperity, and building connected communities; and

WHEREAS, smart growth requires careful planning and direction combined with a clear and effective means of engaging the people's voice; and

WHEREAS, the Palm Beach County Homeless Advisory Board is charged with achieving consensus on dealing with the multi-faceted and complex issue of homelessness and to execute the goals identified in the *Ten-Year Plan to End Homelessness in Palm Beach County*; and

WHEREAS, Amendment 4 seeks to place a constitutional amendment before Florida's voters to amend Article II, Section 7, of the Florida Constitution, (Title: REFERENDA REQUIRED FOR ADOPTION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL COMPREHENSIVE LAND USE PLANS); and

WHEREAS, this amendment may impede progress on smart growth policies aimed at planning for responsible development that addresses the needs of our communities; and

WHEREAS, this amendment may make it more difficult and costly to develop housing for the homeless and to provide services for those facing the threat of homelessness, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOMELESS ADVISORY BOARD THAT:

SECTION 1 The Palm Beach County Homeless Advisory Board advises the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners to oppose Amendment 4.

SECTION 2 The Palm Beach County Homeless Advisory Board advises the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners to urge citizens to vote "NO" on Amendment 4 when it appears on the ballot.

SECTION 3 EFFECTIVE DATE

This Resolution became effective on upon approval by a majority vote of the Palm Beach County Homeless Advisory Board.

The Chairperson thereupon declared the Resolution duly passed and adopted this 17 day of February, 2010.
