Risk Management Meeting:

The action items identified during the Risk Management Meeting on April 16, 2009 were completed. The Fiscal Year 2010 refunding application included updates on the provision of dental services and the Dual Language Committee. The grantee demonstrated that it is working toward ensuring all of the children served receive dental services. A more intense monthly monitoring of dental services by key health staff was implemented, while family service specialists intentionally focused on working closely with the parents of children needing dental treatment. Additionally, the Dual Language Committee has planned a one-day Dual Language Conference for Palm Beach County, scheduled for October 16, 2009.
