I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Supplemental Agreement No. 6 to Project Agreement R2003-1658 in the amount of \$134,448.89 with Wantman Group, Inc. for professional services.

SUMMARY: Approval of this Supplemental Agreement will provide the services necessary for the preparation of design plans and construction bid documents for Palmetto Park Road from west of Powerline Road to I-95.

Background and Justification: On October 21, 2003, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approved an Agreement R2003-1658 with Wantman Group, Inc. (WGI) to provide professional services required to prepare design plans and construction bid documents for Palmetto Park Road from west of Powerline Road to I-95 (Project). Palm Beach County now desires WGI to develop a separate set of construction plans for the Project, as detailed in Exhibit "A" of the attached Supplemental Agreement. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) goal for the Project is 15%. The SBE participation committed for this supplement by WGI is 12.60%. The fee, as detailed in Exhibit "A" of the attached Supplemental Agreement, has been negotiated as just and reasonable compensation as follows:

Basic Services (Lump Sum)	\$ 76,814.39	(Roadway and Drainage Plans, Survey, Permitting, Signing and Marking, Utility, Signal Plans and Street Lighting).
Reimbursable Expenses (Not to Exceed)....	\$ 57,634.50	(Permit Fees, Geotechnical and Reproduction).

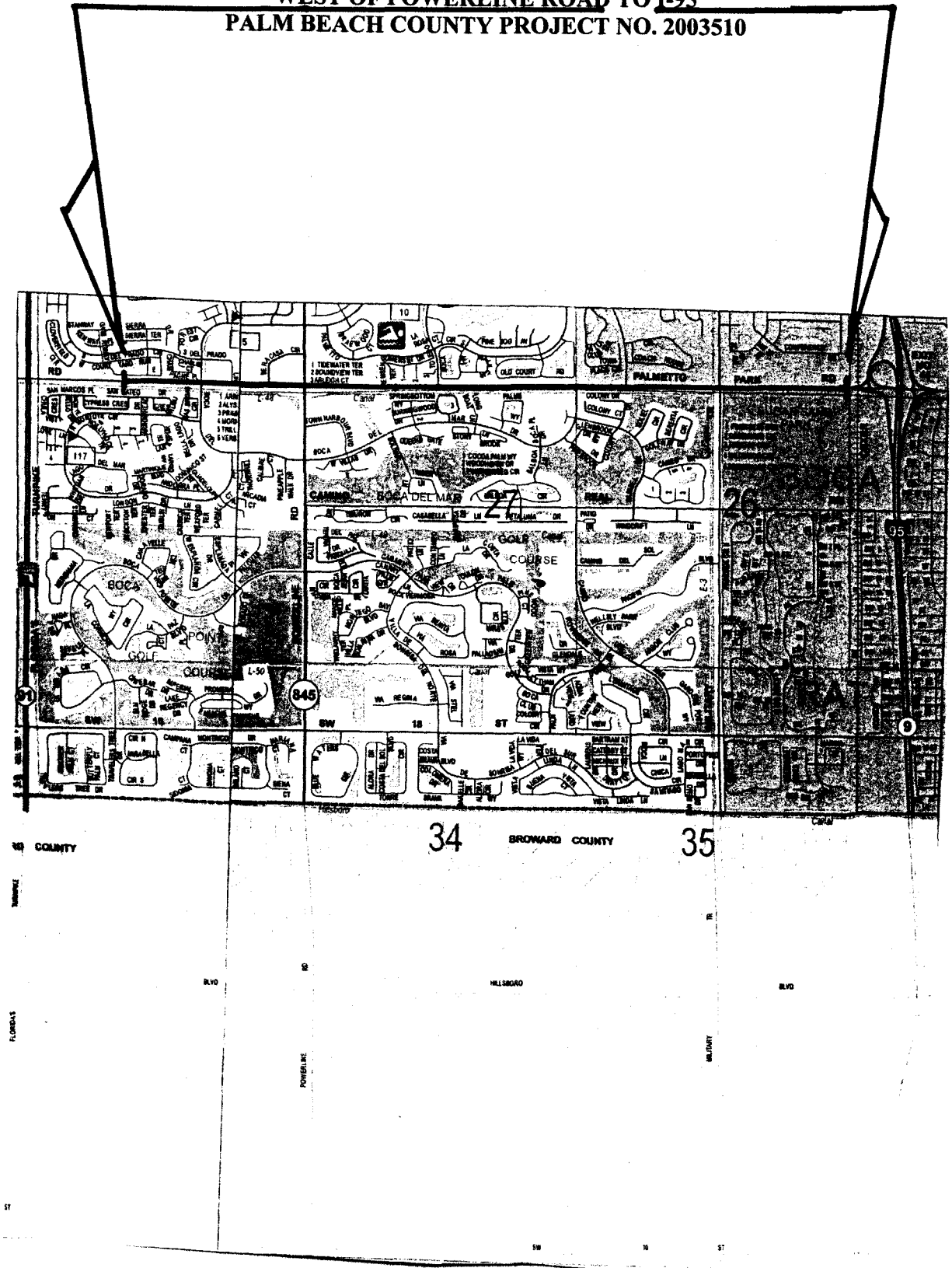

THIS SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT No. 6, made and entered into this day of _____ 2010 by and between Palm Beach County, hereinafter COUNTY, and, Wantman Group, Inc., a Florida Corporation with an address of 2035 Vista Parkway, Suite 100, West Palm Beach, Florida 33411, hereinafter CONSULTANT.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the COUNTY and CONSULTANT entered into a Project Agreement dated October 21, 2003 (R2003-1658), to provide professional engineering services for the design of Palmetto Park Road from W. of Powerline Road to I-95, Palm Beach County, Florida (hereinafter PROJECT); and.

WHEREAS, the COUNTY now desires for the CONSULTANT to prepare design plans and construction bid documents required to develop a separate Phase A set of construction plans for the PROJECT; and

WHEREAS, the following fee has been negotiated as just and reasonable compensation for these professional services to be performed by the CONSULTANT:

Project No. 2003510**

Basic Services in a lump sum fee of **\$76,814.39**;

Reimbursable Services (Not to Exceed) \$57,634.50;

Totaling \$134,448.89

NOW, THEREFORE, THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the mutual benefits to flow from each to the other, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The **CONSULTANT** agrees to provide professional services as described in Exhibit "A" of the Agreement known as "SCOPE OF WORK & FEE".
2. The **CONSULTANT** agrees to "CERTIFICATION" statements as described in Exhibit "B" of the Agreement.
3. The **CONSULTANT** agrees to Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Participation, described in Exhibit "C" of the Agreement.
4. The **CONSULTANT** has provided sub-consultant Letters of Intent to perform as an SBE as described in Exhibit "D" of the Authorization.
5. The **COUNTY** agrees to pay the **CONSULTANT** a fee of One Hundred Thirty-Four Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars and Eight-Nine Cents (\$134,448.89).
6. The **CONSULTANT** agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the **COUNTY** against all claims that may arise as a result of negligence, wrongdoing, misconduct or want of care by the **CONSULTANT**.

Except as hereby amended, changed or modified, all other terms and conditions of the original Agreement dated **October 21, 2003 (R2003-1658)**, and;

Supplements and Amendments thereto, shall remain in full force and effect.

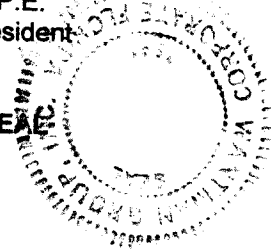

Supplemental Agreement No. 6 provides the following contractual modifications and additional services at the request of Palm Beach County (PBC):

- Revised hourly rates for Supplemental Agreement No. 2. In 2005, PBC split the original design contract for Palmetto Park Road into two Phases. Phase A from “West of Powerline Road to West of Military Trail” and Phase B from “West of Military Trail to Interstate 95. Supplemental Agreement No. 2 accounted for the additional roadway, drainage, signing & pavement marking, and signalization design and plan production effort required to develop a separate Phase A set of construction plans. Supplemental Agreement No. 2 was approved in October of 2006 and was immediately placed on hold by PBC. Supplemental Agreement No. 2 will be voided and all hours will be tabulated in Supplemental Agreement No. 6 at the current hourly rate. Kimley-Horn & Associates (Signalization) and Tierra, Inc. (Geotechnical Services) have also included revised fee estimates, applying current hourly rates to the previously approved hours included as part of Supplemental Agreement No. 2.
- The project limits for Phase A have been changed from “West of Powerline Road to West of Military Trail” to “West of Palmetto Circle North to West of Military Trail”. The change in project limits equates to an additional 1200’ of roadway, drainage, and signing and marking improvements.
- Additional topographic survey will be required to account for changes to the project limits for Phase A and also at the north and south approaches of the intersection Powerline Road to account for FDOT improvements along Powerline Road, currently under construction. The additional survey described above equates to 1000’ of topographic survey beyond the original survey and 500’ of revised topographic survey north and south of Palmetto Park Road along Powerline Road.
- Verification of the original topographic survey for the Phase A limits. Any minor changes will be surveyed and an updated topographic survey for the Phase A limits will be completed.
- Additional drainage design based on SFWMD’s rejection of a additional post-development discharge previously approved by PBC and LWDD.

Below is a summary of the elements of work associated with the additional plan development effort not previously outlined in Supplemental Agreement No. 2:

Roadway (Phase A)

- Provide typical section detail for newly proposed intersection configuration at Palmetto Park Road and Palmetto Circle North.

- Provide two additional plan sheets to cover the 1200' of improvements west of Palmetto Circle North.
- Revise horizontal geometry at the east approach of the intersection of Palmetto Park Road and Palmetto Circle North. Revisions to the plan sheet covering the 500' east of Palmetto Circle North will be necessary.
- Provide two additional profile sheets to cover the 1200' of improvements west of Palmetto Circle North.
- Provide 13 additional cross sections to cover the 1200' of improvements west of Palmetto Circle North.

Drainage (Phase A)

- Design an additional 1200' (each side of the road) of roadside ditches west of Palmetto Circle North.
- Design storm sewer elements for an additional 10 structures and provide drainage structure cross sections.

Drainage (Phase B)

- Redesign of approximately 3 structures to outfall into Cypress Knee Preserve, and design of 3 new structures to provide outfall from Cypress Knee Preserve back into the roadway drainage system.

Permitting (Phase A & Phase B)

- Preparation of SFWMD Water Use Permit application and supporting documentation required for dewatering activities for both Phase A and Phase B (Not included in original contract or subsequent supplemental agreements).

Signing and Pavement Marking (Phase A)

- Provide two additional plan sheets to cover the 1200' of improvements west of Palmetto Circle North and revise plan sheet covering the 500' east of Palmetto Circle North.

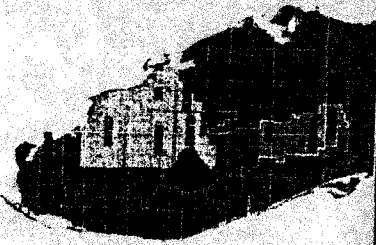

Consumptive use of water is broadly defined as any use of water that reduces the supply from which it is withdrawn or diverted, as prescribed in Part II of Chapter 373, F.S. This authority for consumptive use applies to public water supplies, agricultural and landscape irrigation, construction clean-up, commercial/industrial uses and domestic/irrigating activities.

Water uses not covered by this permitting process include domestic uses for potable water and home irrigation, and water used for the lighting.

A Consumptive Water Use permit allows the holder to withdraw a specified amount of water, either from the ground, a canal, a lake or a river. The water can be used for a public water supply, to irrigate crops, nursery plants or golf courses, for livestock and impoundment, desalination; or for industrial processes.

The South Florida Water Management District issues two types of Consumptive Water Use Permits: general and individual. Issues addressed when evaluating an application:

- ▶ Is the proposed use reasonable and beneficial as defined in Section 373.019 of the Florida Statutes?
- ▶ Will it interfere with other water users in the vicinity?
- ▶ Is it consistent with the public interest (including harm to the environment, wetland intrusion, wetlands, movement of pollution, etc.)?

Consumptive Water Use Permits are issued for a fixed period of time, with an expiration date. All Consumptive Water Use Permits must be renewed prior to the expiration date in order to continue using water.

KHA shall provide the Wantman Group with the approximate locations of the proposed geotechnical testing. The plan will be prepared using Microstation at a scale suitable for reproduction at 1"=20'. The plan set will consist of the summary of quantities, signalization general notes, traffic signal plan and the standard FDOT mast arm index sheets. It is anticipated that we will be able to re-use the Key Sheet, General Notes, Tabulation of Quantities and Pay Item Footnote sheets previously prepared however they will require some modifications to make them specific to this work.

It can be anticipated that there may be minor changes in the roadway/intersection design as a result of Palm Beach County's review comments. Minor adjustments to the signal plan are included in this scope of services. 



As requested, Tierra, Inc. is pleased to submit this proposal for additional services for the above-referenced project. This proposal includes an outline of our proposed scope of work, an estimate of the total fees, and our anticipated schedule for completion of the work.

PROPOSED SCOPE OF WORK

All work performed by Tierra, Inc. will be in general accordance with FDOT standards. We understand that additional fourteen (14) SPT borings will be required for mast arms. We propose to drill these borings to a depth of 35 feet below existing grade.

Within the borings, undisturbed sample collection will be performed in general accordance with the requirements of ASTM D 1587, respectively. Borings will be approximately located in the field by our personnel by measuring distances with a tape from known reference points. Elevations at boring locations can be interpreted from topographic plans if furnished by others.

Upon completion of the field exploration, laboratory testing will be performed on selected samples. The study will be summarized in accordance with the FDOT's Soil and Foundation Manual.

A geotechnical engineer will evaluate the results of all drilling and laboratory testing. A report will be issued that contains the exploration data, a discussion of the site and subsurface conditions, recommendations for foundation design, and a discussion of some construction considerations.

ESTIMATED FEES

It is proposed that the fee for the performance of the services outlined above be determined on a unit price basis in accordance with the attached Fee Schedule, and that the work be performed pursuant to Tierra's General Conditions enclosed herewith and incorporated into this proposal. On the basis of the proposed quantities, it is estimated that the total fee will be approximately \$23,205.00.

Our estimate covers the work needed to present our findings and recommendations in a formal report. Not included are reviews of foundation drawings, preparation of construction specifications, special conferences and any other work requested after submittal of our report.

This estimated fee assumes that the site is readily accessible to our truck-mounted drilling equipment. Any bulldozer or wrecker services required to provide access pathways or mobility assistance to our truck-mounted drill rig are not included in this proposal.

Boring, sampling, and testing requirements are a function of the subsurface conditions encountered. Therefore, the estimated fee previously indicated is approximate, and compensation for the exploration will be based on the actual work and tests performed. We will endeavor to keep the exploration cost at a minimum consisting with good engineering practice.

SCHEDULE AND AUTHORIZATION



Thank you for the opportunity to provide you with the following services for the subject site. This proposal is based on documentation and information provided by your office. We will review any title work supplied by you. The scope of services is as follows:

SCOPE OF SERVICES

I. HORIZONTAL PROJECT NETWORK CONTROL

Using the information supplied by Palm Beach County, we will establish and extend the Right-of-Way for Palmetto Park Road to the west of the previous project (Brown & Phillips project #03-074). A traverse will be run through the route and all found monumentation will be tied in. The survey will be oriented to Palm Beach County horizontal control (NAD 83/90 Adjustment). The Palm Beach County Survey Department will supply all the sectional control information along the proposed route.

II. VERTICAL PROJECT NETWORK CONTROL

A level run will be performed along the route using the existing Palm Beach County benchmarks (NAVD 1988). Benchmarks will be set along the route, not exceeding 600 feet apart, so that we will have at least one benchmark per plan sheet. All benchmarks will be set outside of the proposed right of way.

III. BASELINE LAYOUT

We will lay out the baseline at 100-foot intervals setting appropriate points at each station. The baseline will be laid out within the limits of the route. These baseline points will be used in the topographic and cross section phase to locate features and facilitate checks.

IV. REFERENCE POINTS

We will reference the baseline at intervals not exceeding 1400 feet along the route. These points will be used to replace disturbed baseline stations. We propose to set one (1) reference point.

V. TOPOGRAPHY

A topographic survey will be performed along the route. This survey will tie in all visible features such as, but not limited to, signs, light poles, guardrails, utilities, walks, edge of pavement, curbing, drainage structures, etc. These locations will show all features within the corridor from right of way to right of way extending to 10 feet outside the proposed right of way if provided.

VI. CROSS SECTIONS

Cross sections will be done along the route at 100-foot intervals. These cross sections will cover the roadway to the right of way lines and extend to 25 feet outside of the right of way. In addition we will utilize this new information and generate an updated Tin file.

We will attempt to get asbuilt information on all the pipes leading out of any storm or sanitary sewer structures found. We will show invert elevations, pipe sizes and materials for all pipes located including outfall pipes.

VIII. VERIFICATION OF TOPO

We will do a verification of the original topo for phase A limits (750' west of Palmetto Circle North to Boca Del Mar Drive) Approximately 8,000'. Any minor changes will be relocated to make the survey current. We will also reshoot the entire Powerline Road corridor, including a plateau of the intersection. This is being done due to the current construction and widening of Powerline Road.




