I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: a Contract with Shoreline Foundation, Inc. (Shoreline), the lowest responsive, responsible bidder in the amount of \$1,035,805.24 for the construction of George Bush Boulevard Bridge over the Intracoastal Waterway (Project).

SUMMARY: Approval of this Contract will allow Palm Beach County to issue a Notice to Proceed to Shoreline to begin construction of the Project. The Palm Beach County Small Business Enterprise (SBE) goal for the Project is 15% overall. The SBE participation committed for the Project by Shoreline is 16.03%. Time to complete all work under this contract shall be no more than 150 calendar days. Shoreline is a Broward County company.

Background and Justification: Bids for the Project were received by the Engineering Department on April 20, 2010. Shoreline was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder. The Office of Small Business Assistance issued its SBE evaluation on May 3, 2010.




