I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title:

Staff recommends motion to approve a First Amendment to Professional Services Agreement with Hope Health and Wellness, Inc., to provide fire department physician and related services for a one-year period beginning October 1, 2010, in an amount not-to-exceed \$500,000 annually.

Summary:

The components of the Palm Beach County Fire-Rescue Wellness Program established by the Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) include the provision of a Fire Department Physician, the administering of medical physical examinations and drug testing for Fire-Rescue employees. The Palm Beach County Fire-Rescue Wellness Steering Committee (Committee) is comprised of staff appointed by the Fire-Rescue Administrator and the Professional Firefighters/Paramedics of Palm Beach County (Local 2928), to direct, establish guidelines, make recommendations and evaluate the Fire-Rescue Wellness Program. The Committee is responsible for selecting a service provider and approving a service agreement. On October 6, 2008, the County issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) for Fire-Department Physician and Related Services. Seven proposals were received in response to the RFP. The Committee members evaluated each proposal and selected Hope Health and Wellness, Inc. (Provider) based on a total points scoring system. The current agreement (R2009-0127) is set to expire September 30, 2010; however it provided for three additional one-year periods by written agreement of the parties, and prior written approval of the Committee. The Committee approved a one year renewal of the Agreement, the addition of a fee for onsite blood alcohol testing, and clarification of medical record retention requirements by the current Provider. The Provider provided written agreement to extend the term and provided a per occurrence charge of \$50 for the alcohol testing and a monthly charge of \$150 for the additional storage requirements. The Committee approved the additional charges and prepared this First Amendment to renew the Agreement for a one-year period and revise the Agreement to clarify the medical records retention requirements and to include the additional fees. The total amount to be paid by the County under this Agreement shall not exceed a total annual amount of \$500,000. Hope Health and Wellness, Inc. is a local basiness in Palm Beach County.

Countywide (SGB) Background and Justification:

The Palm Beach County Fire-Rescue Wellness Program was established pursuant to the CBA with the Professional Firefighters/Paramedics of Palm beach County, Local 2928, IAFF, Inc. The CBA established a Wellness Steering Committee responsible for directing, establishing guidelines, making recommendations and evaluating the Wellness program. It is Fire-Rescue's responsibility to administer the Wellness program and a Wellness Coordinator is responsible for the daily operation and management of the Wellness Program. The CBA provides for a Fire-Department Physician, medical physical exams, and drug testing for Fire-Rescue employees. On October 6, 2008, the County issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) for Fire-Department Physician and Related Services. The Committee members evaluated each proposal and selected Hope Health and Wellness, Inc. based on a total points scoring system. The current agreement will expire September 30, 2010, if an amendment is not signed by both parties at least ninety days prior to the expiration. The total amount to be paid by the County under this Agreement shall not exceed a total annual amount of \$500,000.

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

Re: Recommended renewal of Professional Services Agreement with Hope Health and Wellness, Inc. (R2009-0127)

Dear Dr. Hope,

As you are aware, the current Professional Services Agreement with Hope Health and Wellness, Inc. is set to expire on September 30, 2010. This Agreement may be renewed on the same terms and conditions for an additional one-year period provided there is written agreement between the parties executed at least ninety (90) days prior to the expiration of the Agreement. On February 8, 2010, the Wellness Steering Committee (Committee) met and approved a one-year renewal to expire on September 30, 2011.

However, the Committee has requested the addition of blood alcohol testing to be conducted on-site at Hope Health and Wellness. In accordance with Article 18 (Modifications of Work), the COUNTY, has modified the Scope of Work, to include this testing.

The Committee has also requested more stringent record retention practices be placed on employee medical records. Said records must be retained for a period of not less than the employee's term of employment with the County.

Please provide a written response including the following:

- > agreement to a one-year renewal based on the same terms and conditions set forth in the current agreement; and
- > advise if the contemplated change(s) in the Scope of Work, to require onsite blood alcohol testing and provide longer record retention, shall affect your ability to meet the terms and conditions of the current agreement; and
- > advise if the contemplated change(s) in the Scope of Work, to require onsite blood alcohol testing and provide longer record retention, shall result in a fee for said service(s).

FIRST AMENDMENT TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY AND HOPE HEALTH AND WELLNESS, INC. (R2009-0127)

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT, dated	2010,	to
Professional Services Agreement between Palm Beach County and Hope Health and	l Wellne	ss,
Inc., dated January 13, 2009, by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivi	sion of t	:he
State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners (hereinafter ref	erred to	as
the "COUNTY"), and Hope Health and Wellness, Inc., a Florida for-profit corporation,	authoriz	ed
to do business in the State of Florida (hereinafter referred to as "PROVIDER"), who	ose fede	ral
I.D. is 65-0088713.		

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties have entered into that certain Professional Services Agreement (R2009-0127) dated January 13, 2009, hereinafter referred to as the "AGREEMENT", whereby the PROVIDER has agreed to provide professional services in the area of occupational health and safety, as more specifically set forth in the Scope of Work detailed in Article 3 of the AGREEMENT, including but not limited to providing the delivery of medical physicals to Palm Beach County Fire-Rescue employees, providing for a "Fire Department Physician", providing for a Medical Review Officer (MRO), providing for professional medical staff, and providing for direction for the medical component of Palm Beach County Fire-Rescue's Wellness program; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article 2 of the AGREEMENT, the parties desire to renew the AGREEMENT for the period October 1, 2010 through and including September 30, 2011, as approved by the Wellness Steering Committee; and

WHEREAS, on December 15, 2009, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance No. 2009-049, the Palm Beach County Office of Inspector General Ordinance ("IG Ordinance"). This Ordinance authorizes the Inspector General to conduct audits of, require reports from, and receive access to the records of all County Departments; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article 18 of the AGREEMENT, the Wellness Steering Committee has approved modifying the Scope of Work to clarify that the PROVIDER shall retain all employee medical records for the entire duration of the AGREEMENT, and to include a monthly fee for records storage costs, which fee shall not require any increase to the existing annual not-to-exceed contract amount; and

WHEREAS, the Wellness Steering Committee has approved including a fee for alcohol level testing to be provided in accordance with the drug testing services under the AGREEMENT, which fee will not require any increase to the existing annual not-to-exceed contract amount; and

WHEREAS, the PROVIDER has advised that the contemplated modifications shall not affect its ability to meet the terms and conditions of the AGREEMENT.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements expressed herein, the COUNTY and the PROVIDER agree as follows:

- In accordance with Article 2 of the AGREEMENT, the AGREEMENT is hereby renewed for an additional one year period commencing October 1, 2010, and shall remain in full force and effect up to and including September 30, 2011, unless sooner terminated or renewed as provided for in the AGREEMENT.
- 2. The AGREEMENT is hereby amended to add the following Article:

"Article 31 -Palm Beach County Office of the Inspector General

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 2009-049, Palm Beach County has established the Office of the Inspector General, which is authorized and empowered to review past, present and proposed County contracts, transactions, accounts and records. All contractors and parties doing business with the County and receiving County funds shall fully cooperate with the Inspector General. The Inspector General has the power to subpoena witnesses, administer oaths, require the production of records, and to audit, investigate, monitor, and inspect the activities of the contractor, its officers, agents, employees, and lobbyists in order to ensure compliance with contract specifications and to detect waste, corruption and fraud."

3. The AGREEMENT is hereby amended to add the following Article:

"Article 32 - Medical Record Retention

The PROVIDER shall retain and maintain for the entire duration of the AGREEMENT, including all renewals periods, any and all employee medical records produced or received by the PROVIDER as a result of the AGREEMENT, including any and all services performed under the AGREEMENT. 'Employee medical records' includes, but is not limited to, medical/employment histories and complaints; medical examination and laboratory/diagnostic test records, charts, films, and results; medical opinions, diagnoses, notes, and recommendations; and duty recommendation forms."

- 4. The AGREEMENT is hereby amended to revise **Exhibit B**, as attached hereto and incorporated herein, to add the following fees to the Price Proposal Page: \$50 for each Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) Test and \$150 per month for storage of all employee medical records.
- All other provisions of the AGREEMENT are hereby confirmed and, except as specifically provided for herein, are not otherwise altered or amended and shall remain in full force and effect.
- 6. This First Amendment to the AGREEMENT shall take effect on October 1, 2010.
